

INTERNSHIP DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING & ENVIRONMENT

The Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) is seeking an Intern for the Department of Planning & Environment to assist with planning and research related to transportation safety and active transportation. Applicants will gain a clear understanding of regional planning and its principles, practices, and techniques.

Assignments may include specific projects or policy issues related to pedestrian, bicycle, and safety planning. The ideal candidate should be able to conduct independent research, perform field work (such as setting up automated pedestrian and bicycle counters), have experience in conducting statistical analyses, provide benchmarking and best practices reports, and assist with meeting and event preparation.

This position requires strong communication skills (both written and verbal) and organizational skills. Working knowledge of MS Office is essential. Good statistical analytical abilities are desired. Experience with Graphic Design and ArcGIS is helpful. This is a team oriented position, although the applicant must possess the ability to work independently. A strong work ethic and excellent interpersonal communication skills are a must.

Applicant must be currently enrolled in a college or university. Fields related to City and Regional Planning, Transportation, Engineering, Urban Planning, or Geography are preferred.

Estimated start date would be May, 2017. Interns typically are employed up to 20 hours per week during semesters with classes and up to 40 hours per week during academic breaks.
