The Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) is seeking an intern for the Department of Planning & Environment to assist with the insight2050 Technical Assistance Program (TA Program). *insight2050* is a collaborative initiative among public and private partners designed to help communities proactively plan for development and population growth over the next 30+ years that is expected to be dramatically different from the past. Through the TA Program, MORPC staff will offer assistance to local government members within the boundary of the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the planning of transportation and community development efforts related to the findings of insight2050 and the goals of the Metropolitan Transportation Plan. Applicants will gain a clear understanding of regional planning and its principles, practices and techniques, and collaborating with local governments. The applicant will work under the direct supervision of full-time staff.

Assignments will include collecting, analyzing and summarizing data and best practices in planning concepts related to Complete Streets policies, infill & redevelopment, and transportation network mobility & accessibility. In addition, the candidate will assist to curate and develop resources related to the insight2050 initiative and other related Department programs. The ideal candidate should be able to conduct independent research and synthesize it for various audiences.

The position requires strong communication skills (both written and verbal), research and organization skills. Working knowledge of MS Office is essential. Experience with Graphic Design, website development, and ArcGIS is helpful. This a team-oriented position, although the applicant must possess the ability to work independently. A strong work ethic and excellent interpersonal communication skills are a must.

Applicant must be currently enrolled in a college or university graduate program. Fields related to City and Regional Planning, Transportation, Urban Planning, or Geography are preferred.

Estimated start date is August 2017. Interns typically are employed up to 20 hours per week during semesters when classes are in session and up to 40 hours per week during academic breaks.
