

MORPC-attributable funds are federal funds set aside for the Central Ohio region by the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT). They can be used for transportation projects and programs located in the planning area.


The funds are from three federal programs:

- Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (CMAQ)
- Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP).

SFY (State Fiscal Year): Begins on July 1 of the prior calendar year and ends on June 30 of the calendar year. SFY 2016 begins July 1, 2015 and ends June 30, 2016.

LR (Long Range): Construction funds are anticipated after SFY 2019 and are not included in the TIP. Other phases of the project, such as preliminary engineering or right-of-way, have funds in the TIP.

NA (Not Applicable): The project does not have a construction phase, but comprises a program, purchase or planning activity.

Cost: Total estimated project costs in SFY 2016 or later. Project costs prior to SFY 2016 are excluded.
