- B. Use the icons at the top to turn layers, legends, etc. on and off.
- C. Use the + and buttons to zoom in and out.
- D. There are several layers available to you to turn on and off.
 - 1) Transportation Planning Area MORPC's transportation study area boundary.
 - 2) Labels of community names.
 - 3) Thematic layers of where growth is projected: toggle these on to see where projected growth is proposed.
 - Household Growth
 - Total Job Growth
 - Retail Job Growth (includes services such as auto repair, restaurants, hotels and stores)
 - Office Job Growth
 - Industrial (includes warehouses, mini storage and distribution centers)
 - Other Job Growth (hospitals, government and schools)
 - 4) View existing and future data by geographies
 - Community Sub-Areas: each community has been subdivided into sub-areas
 - With the "Community Sub-Areas" layer toggled on:
 - Click on the area to get a pop-up box that includes information about existing and future population, households and employment.
 - Scroll to the next page in the pop-up to get totals for communities
 - o Columbus places are displayed by city planning area, not as the entire city.
 - When the SUB-AREA LAYER IS TURNED OFF, click on the area for a pop-up box of information about existing and future population, households and employment.
 - Total Places: transparent shading of communities in their totality.
 - 5) Community Boundaries are the outlines of communities.
 - This layer may be helpful to keep turned on see the boundaries of your community.
