## Recommendation:

Create a sustainability-focused Committee on Commission that will replace the Center Advisory Council and align with MORPC's structure.



# Purpose:

To evaluate and advise the Commission on matters of regional importance pertaining to environmental sustainability, conservation, and development.



## Process and Status:

MORPC Center for Energy & Environment Advisory Council provided recommendations




MORPC staff compiled recommendations and drafted bylaws language for review



Language presented to the MORPC Bylaws Committee for input and a vote

## Proposed Composition:

- 12 member minimum, with maximum to be determined by the Committee
- Chair and Vice-Chair both MORPC Commission members
- 1 appointed representative from each of the working groups (currently 4)
- 3 representatives from the Green Pact
- 3 seats to represent diverse stakeholders in the region



## Role:

- Serve as voice of sustainability focused programming
- Advise working groups as sub-committees
- Bring policy and program recommendations to the Commission
- Support key objectives of the Public Policy Agenda, Green Pact
- Establish sub-committees as needed

## Next Steps:

- MORPC Executive Committee vote June 5<sup>th</sup>
- MORPC Commission vote (pending approval)  
June 12<sup>th</sup>
- Begin process of selecting leadership and members in July if approved
