Two Infrastructure Programs

SCIP (Issue 2)

State Capital Improvement Program

- Created in 1987
- Sale of bonds
- Reauthorized in 1995, 2005, 2014
- \$150 million per yr – 2015
- \$175 million next 5 yrs
- \$200 million last 5 years

LTIP

Local Transportation Improvement Program

- Created in 1989
- 1 cent per/gal. gasoline tax
- Provides about \$59 million in gasoline tax receipts each year


Other SCIP Funds

Emergency Funds

- Preservation of health, safety, & welfare
- \$ 3 million per yr – 2015
- \$ 3.5 million next 5 yrs
- \$ 4 million last 5 years
- Contact Director Miller at Ohio Public Works Commission

Small Government

- Communities with < 5,000 population
- \$ 15 million per yr – 2015
- \$ 17.5 million next 5 yrs
- \$ 20 million last 5 years
- District submits up to 7 applications
- Small Government Commission makes recommendations to the Ohio Public Works Commission
