- Approval of Resolution T-19-15 containing MORPC's TRAC project prioritization


Transportation Review Advisory Council (TRAC)

- Responsible for committing funding toward the Major New Capacity Program projects
- Qualifying projects cost over \$12 million and increase roadway capacity and/or reduce congestion
- MPOs provide ODOT a local project prioritization recommendation as part of the project evaluation process.

MORPC's TRAC Project Prioritization Evaluation


- Four projects were submitted within MORPC's MPO area
- MORPC staff evaluated the projects using the 2016-2040 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) goals and objectives and the MTP key elements evaluation criteria
- Public comment period held August 7th to September 11th. Four comments received, all on the Far East Freeway improvements

Recommended Prioritization

-  Priority No. 1: Columbus Crossroads I-70/I-71 East Freeway (construction funding)
-  Priority No. 2: Far East Freeway Phase 1 (construction funding)
-  Priority No. 3: Far East Freeway Phase 2 & 3 (detailed design funding)
-  Priority No. 4: I-270/US-23 South Outerbelt Phase 2 (construction funding)
-  MPO Boundary
