


The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is the 4-year program of projects and strategies implementing the near-term priorities in the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP).




## The TIP:

- Includes only projects in the MTP
- Identifies funding committed to each project
- Is constrained by available funding
- Requires approval by MORPC, the Governor, and U.S. DOT
- Is analyzed for impacts on air quality and disadvantaged populations
- Is updated every two years and amended quarterly

**A project or strategy must be in the TIP before it can use federal funds.**



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


## Funding by Source




## Funding by Project Type












### Bridge and Roadway Maintenance Projects














## Active Transportation Projects

Transit, 2016-2019**






