

# Funding Management Process



# Application Timeline 2016-17

- **August 31:** AFC action on updates to previous commitments
- **October 5:** Review of MORPC staff's preliminary scoring and ranking of the applications
- **November 2:** Review of the staff's revised ranking within each Activity Category and development of a draft recommendation for new funding commitments
- **November 16:** Presentation of member feedback on the draft recommendation and progress toward endorsing the recommendation
- **November 30:** Final adjustments to the draft recommendation of funding commitments and approval for the public review and comment period
- **December:** Draft list of funding commitments available for public review and comment
- **March 2017:** Adopt list of attributable funding commitments

## Updates to Previous Funding Commitments

- Through previous rounds, MORPC has committed \$180.5M to 38 projects in SFY17 and later
- 33 projects with existing funding commitments have requested minor adjustments totaling \$7.4M
- 5 projects requested significant additional funding and are re-competing with the new applications






Avery Road Widening Project Area


