What are we asking of you today?

- Consideration of Resolution T-13-16:
“Establishing Priorities for Central Ohio
Candidate Projects submitted for TRAC funding in
2016”

Transportation Review Advisory Council (TRAC)

- Commits funding for Major New Capacity Program projects
- Eligible projects cost over \$12 million, increase capacity and/or reduce congestion
- MPOs provide ODOT a local project prioritization recommendation

Criteria for 2016 Application Round

- Existing TRAC-funded projects (Tier I, II or III) needing funds to advance
- New projects with significant impact on jobs, regional economic impact and have non-ODOT funding commitments
- Extra consideration to projects with non-ODOT funding commitments of 30% or greater of the total project cost

MORPC's TRAC Project Prioritization Evaluation

- Four projects requesting funds were submitted within MORPC's MPO area
- MORPC staff evaluated the projects using the 2016-2040 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) goals and objectives and the MTP key elements evaluation criteria
- Public comment period held August 11th to September 16th. Over 100 letters of support were submitted for the US 33/SR 161/Post Road interchange; one letter submitted in support of the Delaware Point project




MORPC Project Ranking Recommendation

Based on MTP-based evaluation, the public comments received and the phase for which funds are being requested, MORPC recommends the following priority ranking:

2016 TRAC Projects

Recommended Prioritization

-  Priority No. 1 Far East Freeway (\$7 million for detailed design)
-  Priority No. 2 Delaware Point Project (\$1.5 million for detailed design)
-  Priority No. 3 SR161/US33/Post Road interchange (\$20.68 million for construction)
-  Priority No. 4 I71/US36/SR37 Interchange (\$10 million for construction)
-  MPO Boundary
