

Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility for Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program

The 5310 program provides capital and operating grants for public transportation services that are planned, and designed to be carried out to meet the needs of seniors and individuals with disabilities in the Columbus Urbanized Area.

A new funding cycle for the Section 5310 Program begins Friday **November 20, 2015** and ends on Wednesday **January 27, 2016**.

Eligible Recipients

- Private non-profit organizations
- State and local governments
- Public or private operators of public transportation services

This program provides federal funds for

- 80 % of the cost of capital projects requiring a 20 % match.
- 50% federal funds requiring a 50% match for operating projects.

Two Information Sessions will be held at MORPC, 111 Liberty Street, Suite 100, Columbus. Those who are considering a funding request for a 5310 grant are encouraged to attend.
