Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission to Provide More Assistance to Local Government Members

(Columbus – May 11, 2017) The Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) has announced the launch of the insight2050 Technical Assistance (TA) Program.

The program will provide MORPC’s local government members located within its transportation planning area (Delaware and Franklin counties, Bloom and Violet townships in Fairfield County, New Albany, Pataskala and Etna Township in Licking County, and Jerome Township in Union County) with assistance from MORPC staff in the planning of transportation and community development efforts related to the findings of insight2050 and the 2016-2040 Metropolitan Transportation Plan.

The MORPC insight2050 TA Program awards planning services via a competitive application process. Successful applicants will receive MORPC staff expertise in community-based planning services that align with existing or proposed community projects establishing a strong connection to the strategies of the Metropolitan Transportation Plan and the insight2050 findings.

Services will be provided for specific projects related to transportation, air quality, traffic and other projects that support consideration of transportation in land use planning and/or demonstrate the benefits of various modes of transportation.
