MORPC Accepting Funding Applications for Transportation Projects

(Columbus – June 6, 2016) The Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) is seeking applications for funding transportation projects and programs from local public agencies located in Delaware and Franklin counties, Bloom and Violet townships in Fairfield County, New Albany, Pataskala and Etna Township in Licking County, and Jerome Township in Union County. The funding will be available for State Fiscal Years 2018–2023.

These funds may be used for construction, expansion, reconstruction or preservation of roads and bridges; capital costs for public transit; bicycle and pedestrian facilities; and other transportation-related activities. MORPC estimates \$40 million to \$50 million will be available; the majority of funds will be available after 2021.
