WHAT: As part of pre-conference activities, the 5th Safe Routes to School National Conference is hosting an open street and protected bike lane demonstration

WHERE: Poplar Avenue Parklet, at the intersection of North High Street and Poplar Street (just north of Stack City Restaurant, 600 N High Street, on the east of High Street)

HOW: Poplar Avenue will be closed and there will be safety demonstrations, as well as a protected bike lane demonstration that is similar to the new protected bike lane on Summit Street. The event is free and open to the public.
