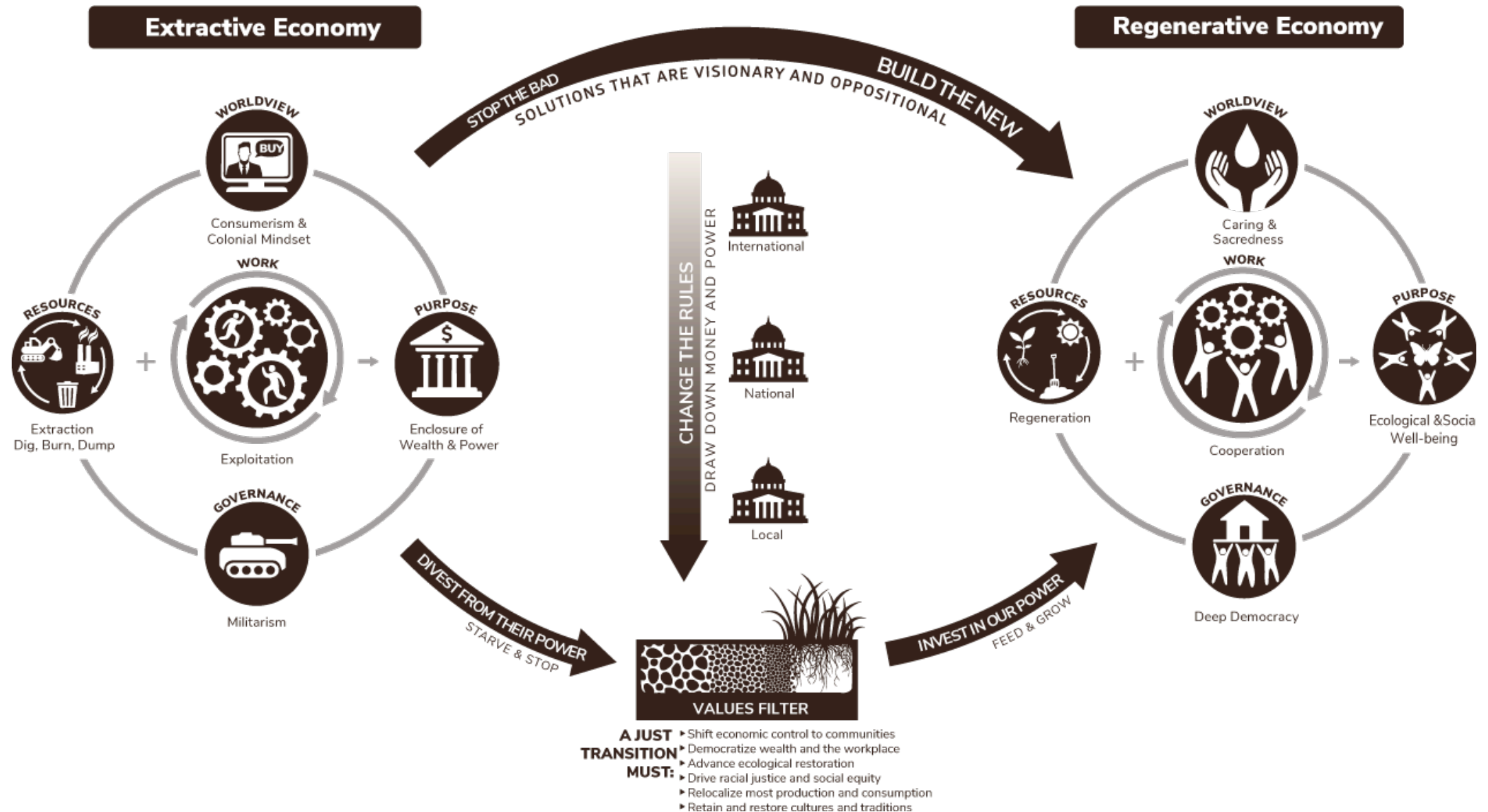

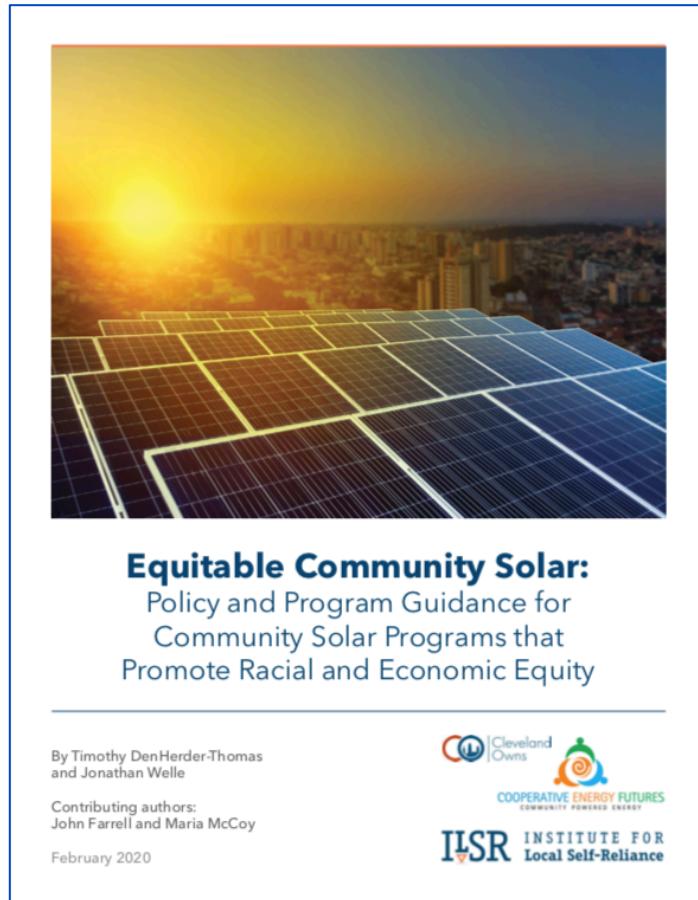
The BC is working on three fronts to build the community solar garden

- Fund the project
- Acquire land
- Pass authorizing legislation (or receive one-off discretionary approval)

Just Transition framework from Climate Justice Alliance



Cleveland Owns' 'Equitable Community Solar' policy framework identifies 30 specific policies to promote racial and economic equity



- The policies are clustered in four areas:
 - Compensation
 - Customer participation
 - Program structure
 - Governance, transparency, and other
- We find \$1 million in upfront costs generates 10 jobs and \$1.7 million in economic impact
