## **Purpose and Intent**




- The U.S. EPA Brownfields Assessment Grant
  - Creates opportunities for organizations like MORPC to provide funds to communities and individual property owners seeking to assess their property for hazardous substance contamination.
  - MORPC was awarded **\$600,000** for this grant period
- It's estimated that over **450,000 properties** in the United States are currently taking part in the Brownfields program
- MORPC's Role
  - Receives assessment requests
  - Provides funding for brownfield assessments conducted by SME-USA consultants and engineers.
  - · Connects with the broader Columbus region community
- Property owners are given the tools to revitalize unused land and reinvest in their community through development.

#### **Overall Impact**



- Completed assessments for 15 different properties in Hocking County, Franklin County, Ross County
- Total approved dollars spent: \$495,781 of \$600,000 as of May 2022

#### **Notable Projects**

- Gladden House
  - Community house in Franklinton, Columbus, OH
  - Dedicated to providing support for underserved communities and marginalized peoples
- Wirthman Brothers Property
  - Former salvage yard and gasoline filling station in Whitehall, OH
  - Currently being evaluated for contamination to be redeveloped for future commercial use
- Columbus Fair Auto Auction
  - Previously a car auction lot in Gahanna, OH contaminated with motor vehicle waste and hazardous spills
  - Future mixed-use development in the Rickenbacker Area within the Southside Opportunity Zone
