New Program Purpose


- New focus on moving from plan/concept to project implementation
- Address regional goals established in the MTP
- Advance specific MTP strategies focused on active transportation and transit infrastructure
- Move toward annual program with shorter project timeframes
- Requiring **more detailed scopes** of work for selected activities



Program Eligibility

- Local government member within the MPO
- Services requested are within the scope of the TA Program
- Application must meet threshold score
- Application must be complete (including signed letter of commitment)
- Application must be received prior to the application deadline

Applicant Responsibilities

Designation of staff time commitment and specific Project Manager

Provision of any relevant data or materials

Participation from relevant departments within the local agency

Regular communication with appropriate community stakeholders

Regularly scheduled check-ins with MORPC staff **Consistent and timely review** of all materials submitted

ATC 2022 Strategy – Working Groups

- The working groups will exist for project duration or until the ATC Chairs and Working Group chair deem necessary, whichever comes first.

Mission:

2. **Collaborate** on and coordinate efforts **to significantly reduce severe injuries and fatalities** for people walking and bicycling or using active transportation facilities throughout our region.


3. **Increase regional stakeholders' understanding** of the sustainability, economic, health, social, and transportation benefits of a connected active transportation network.
