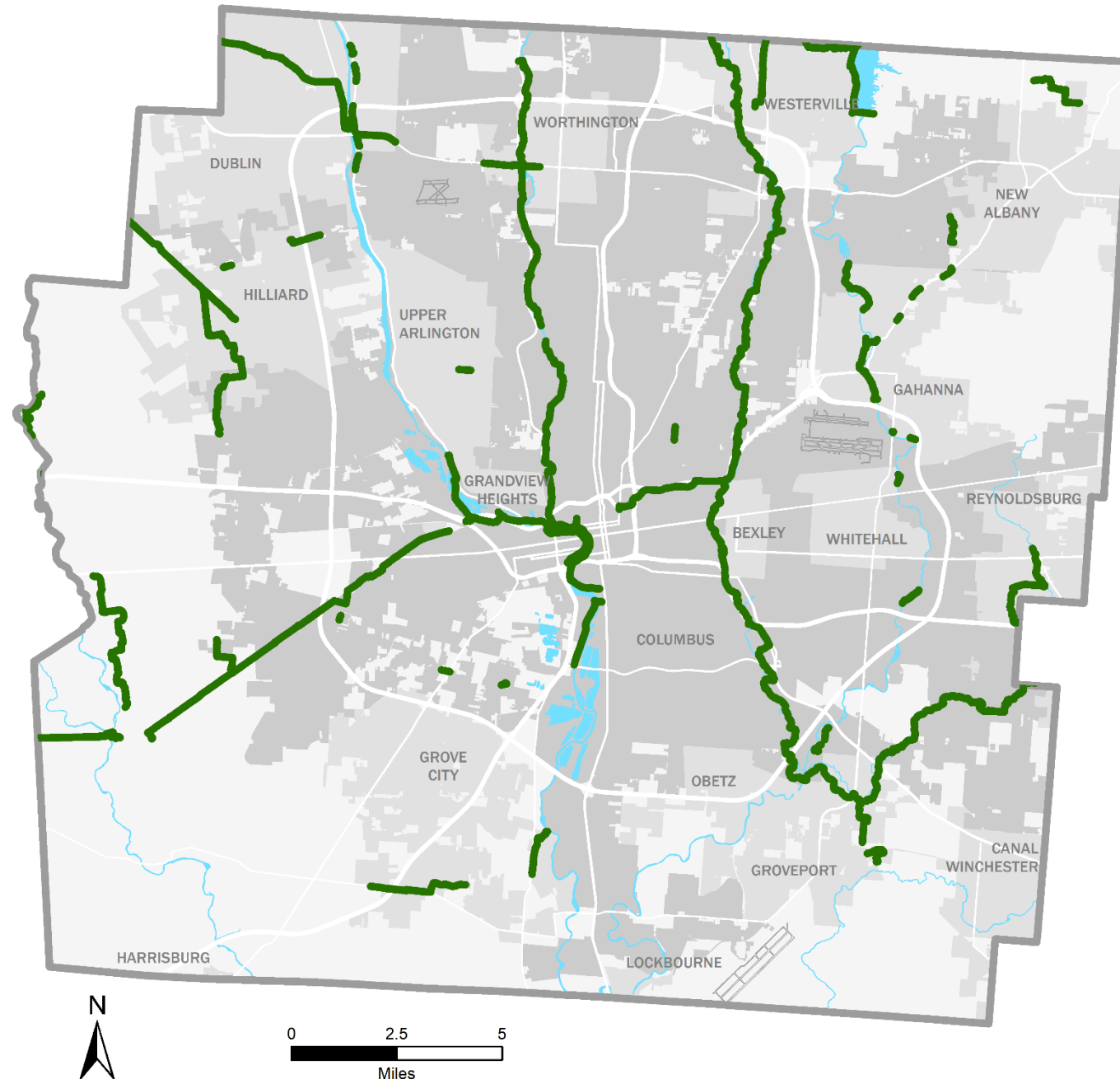

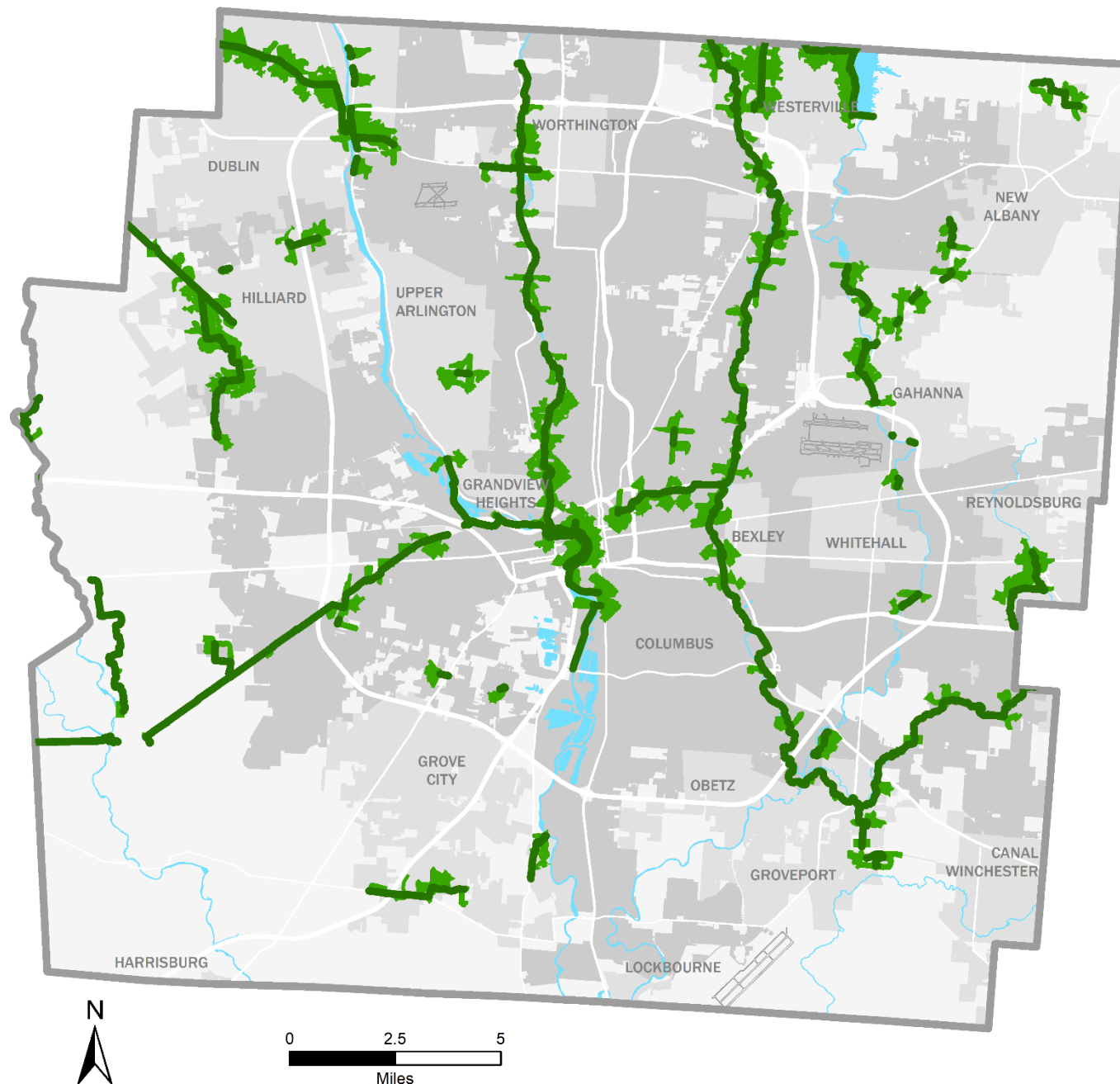

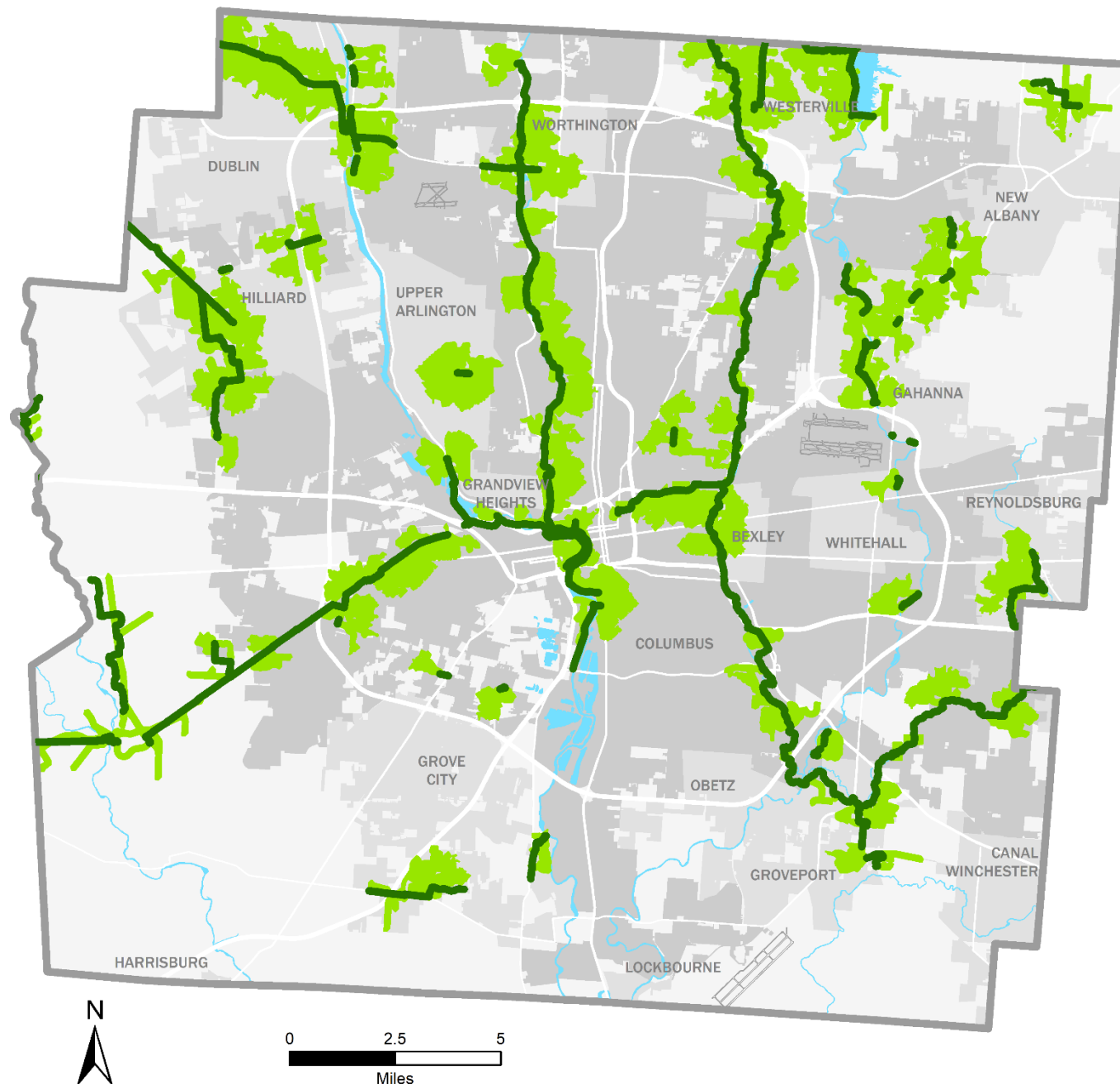

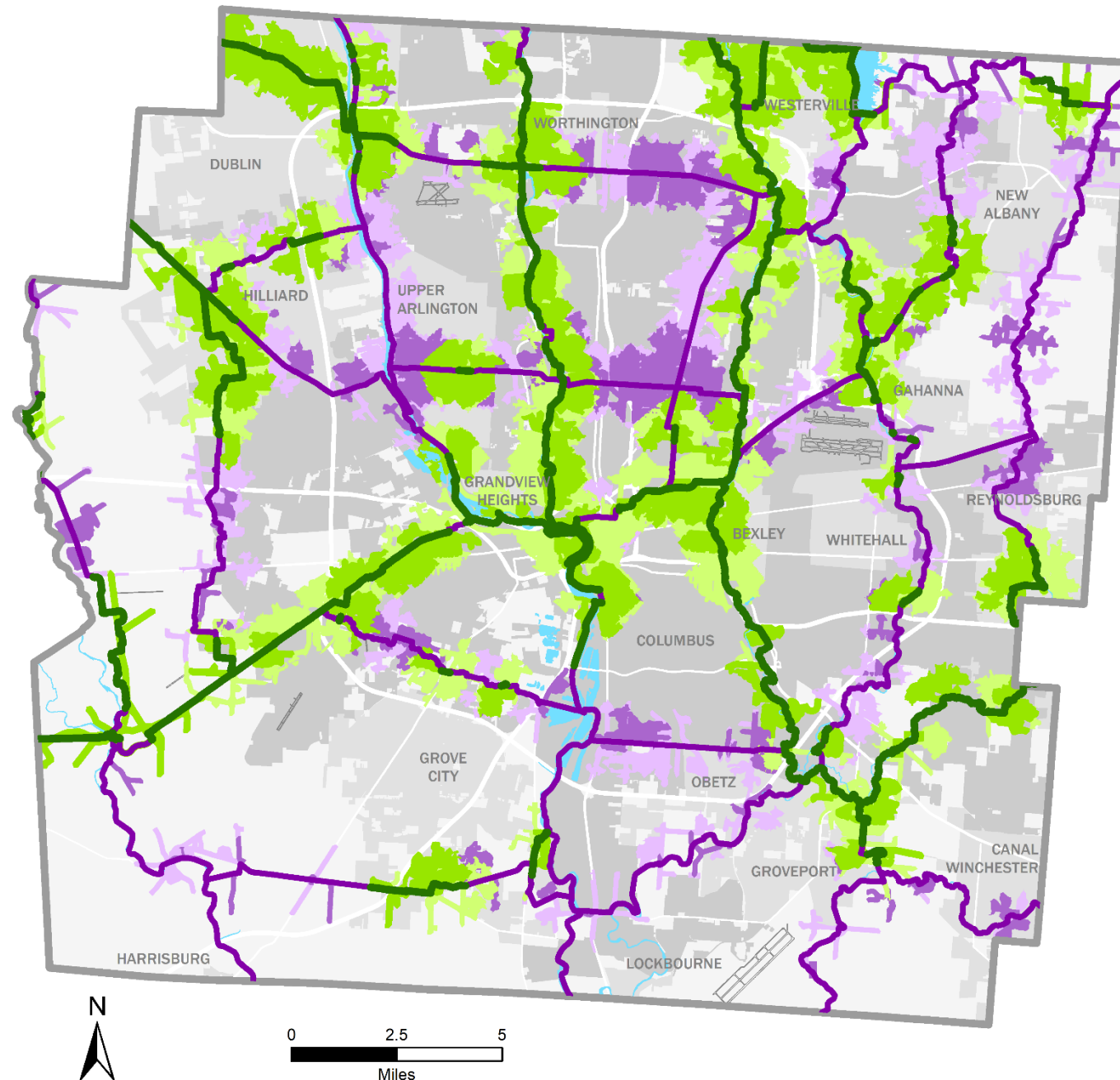

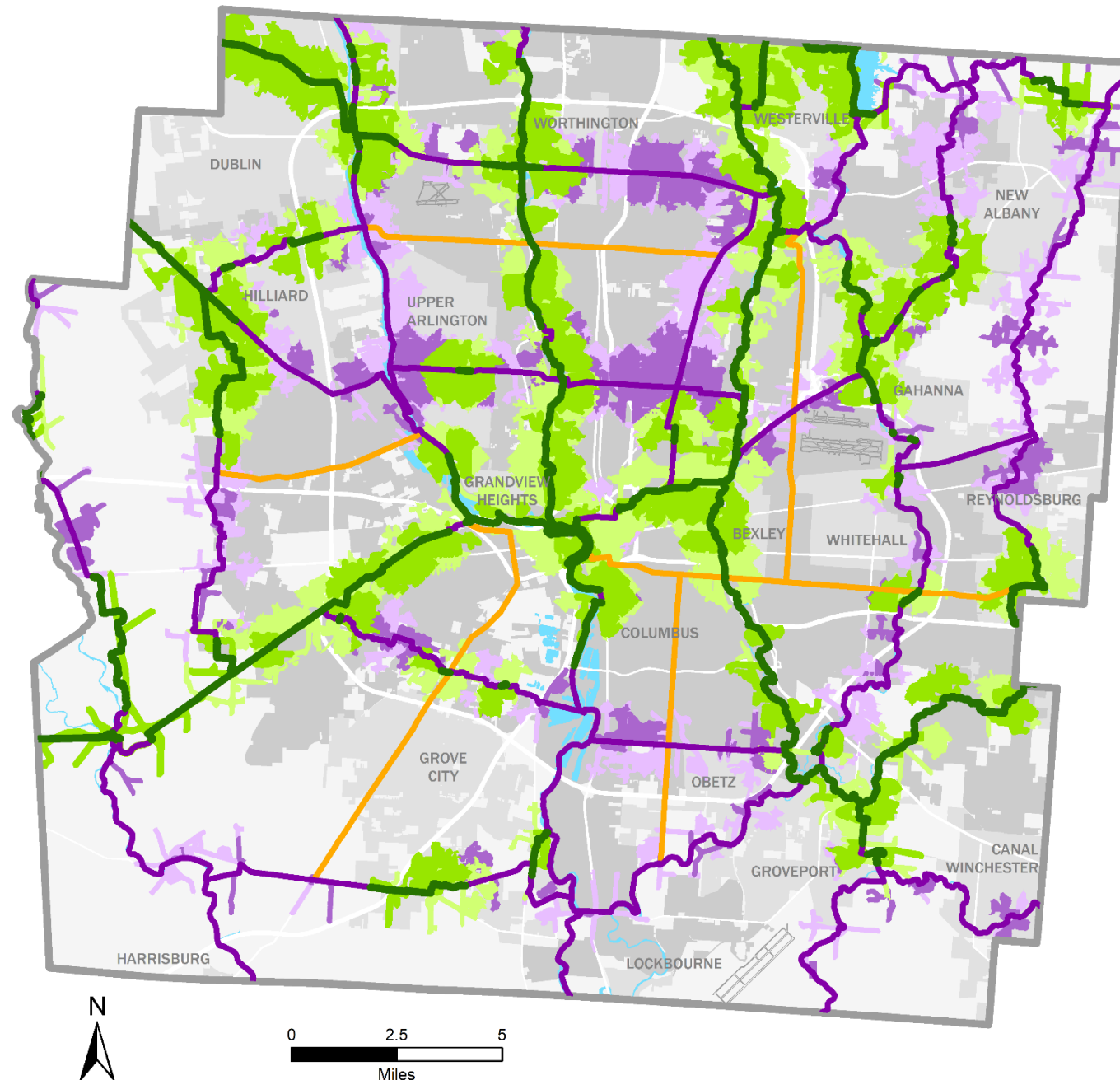

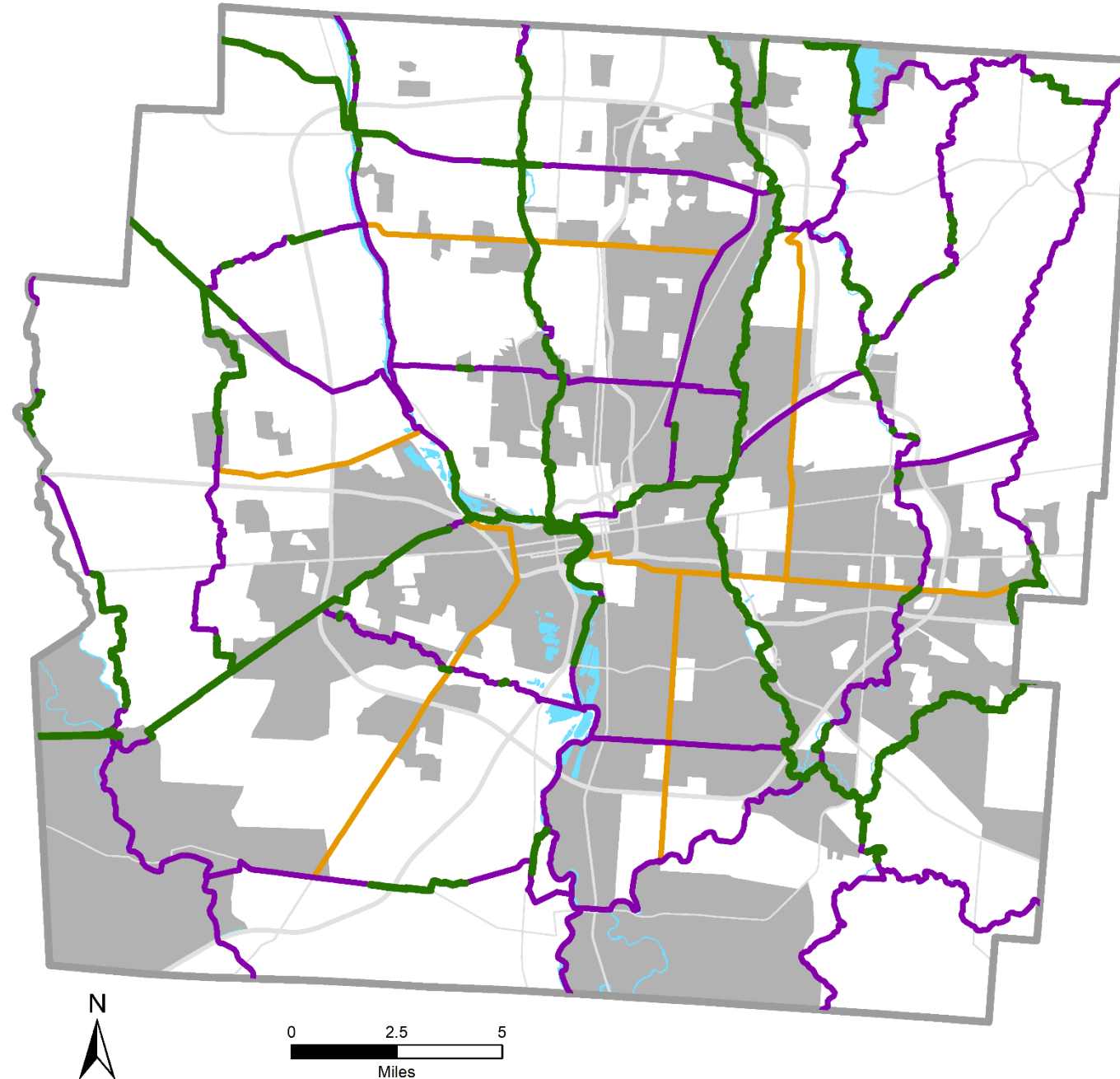

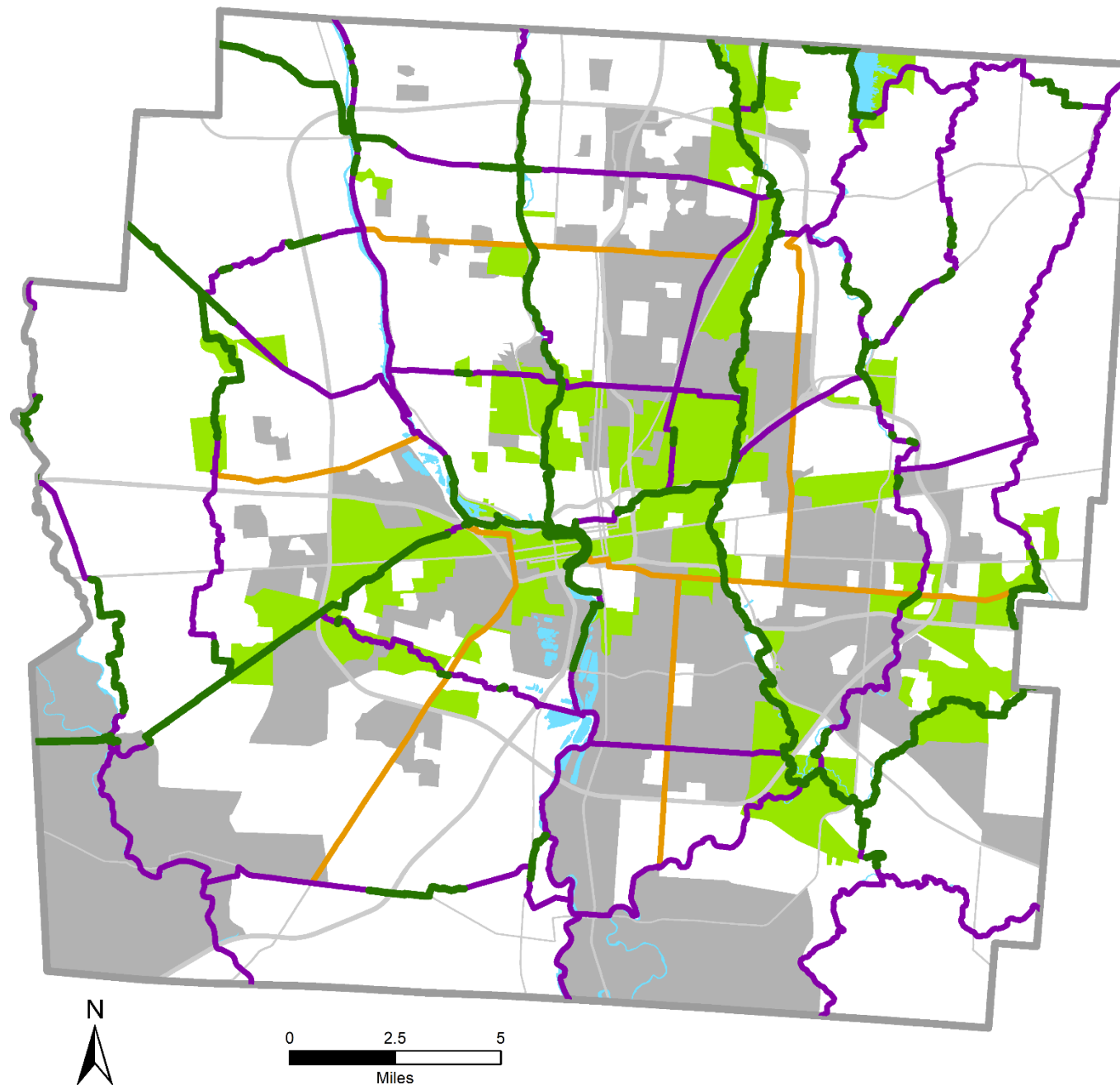

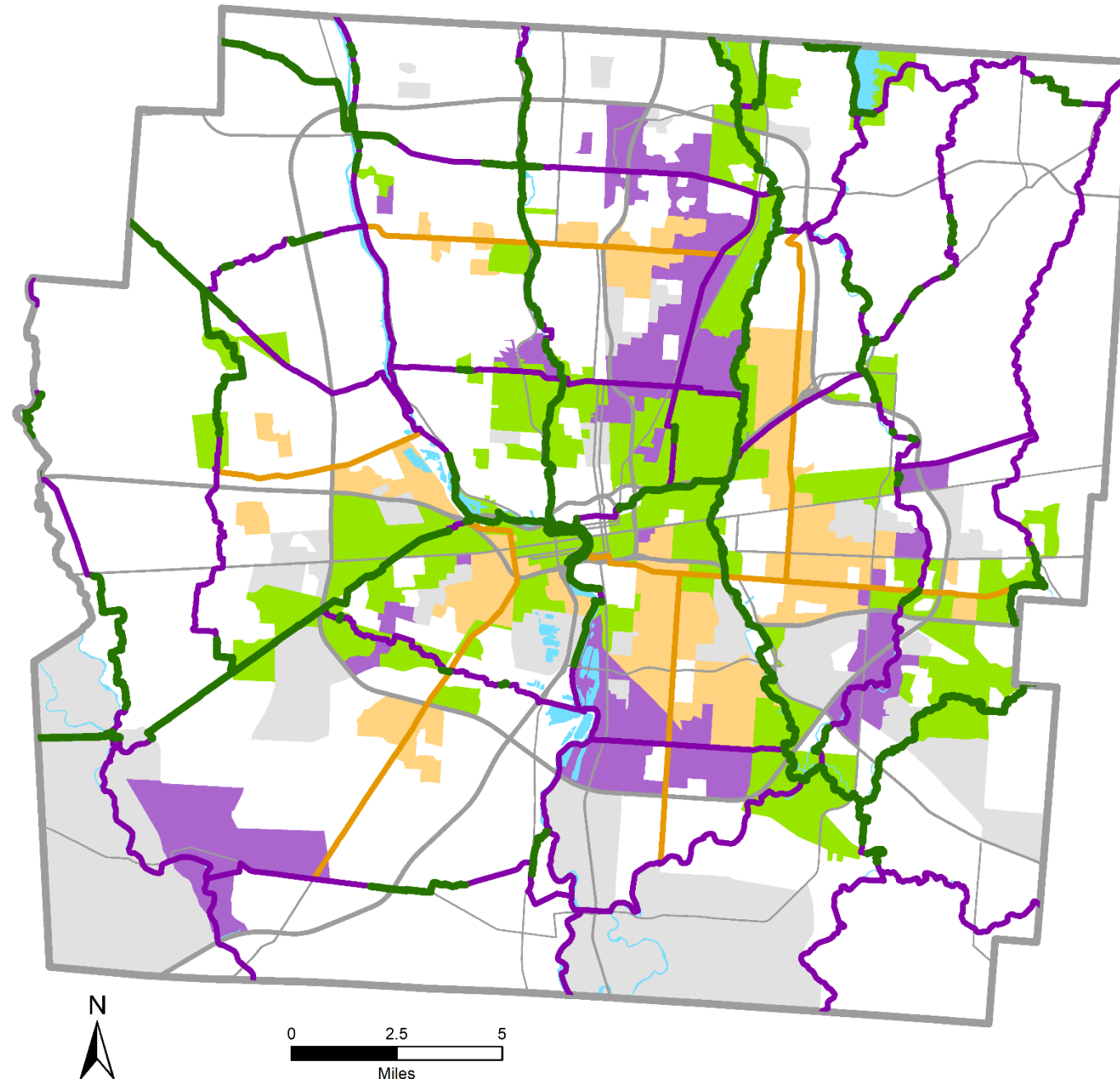

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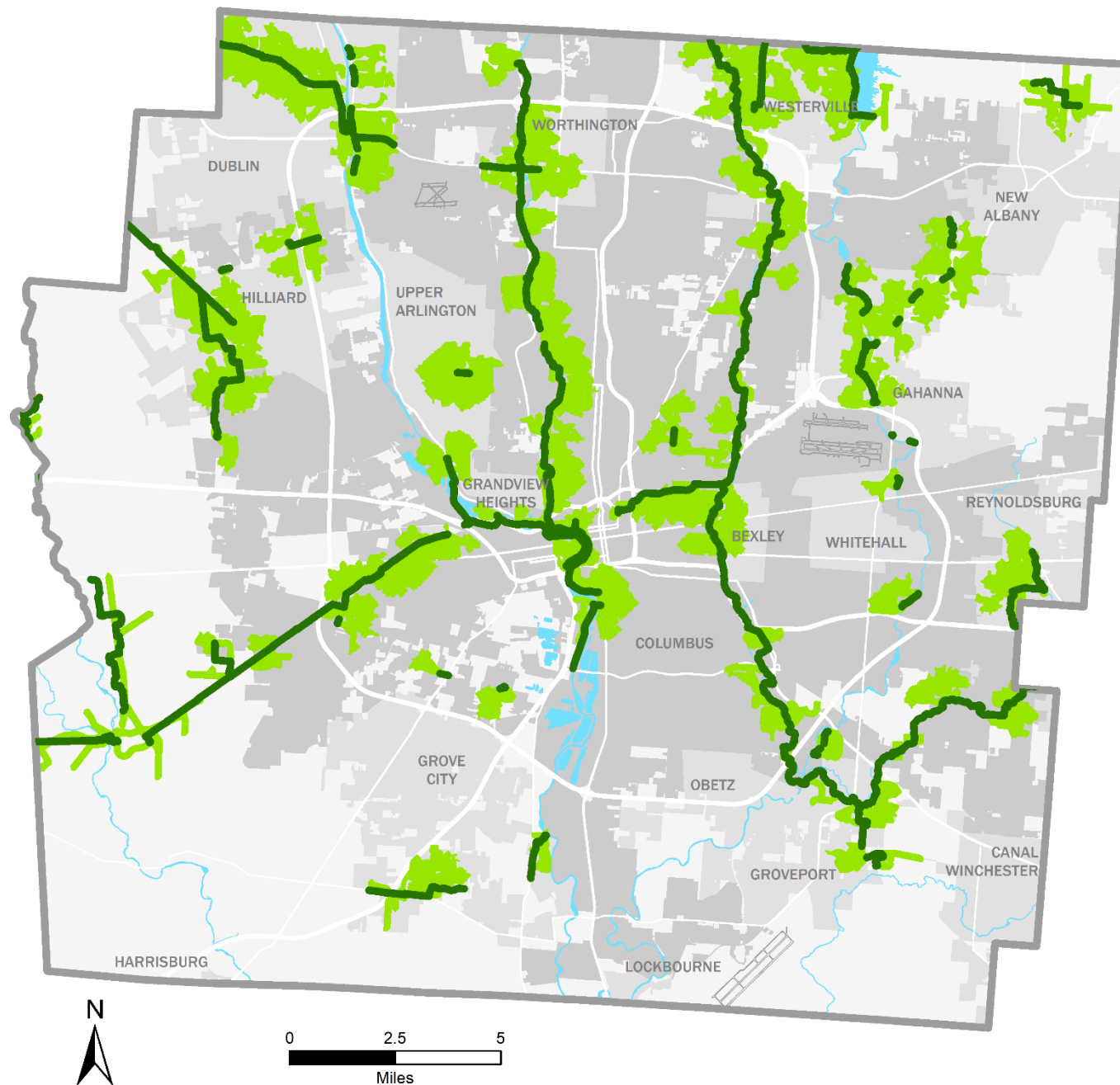

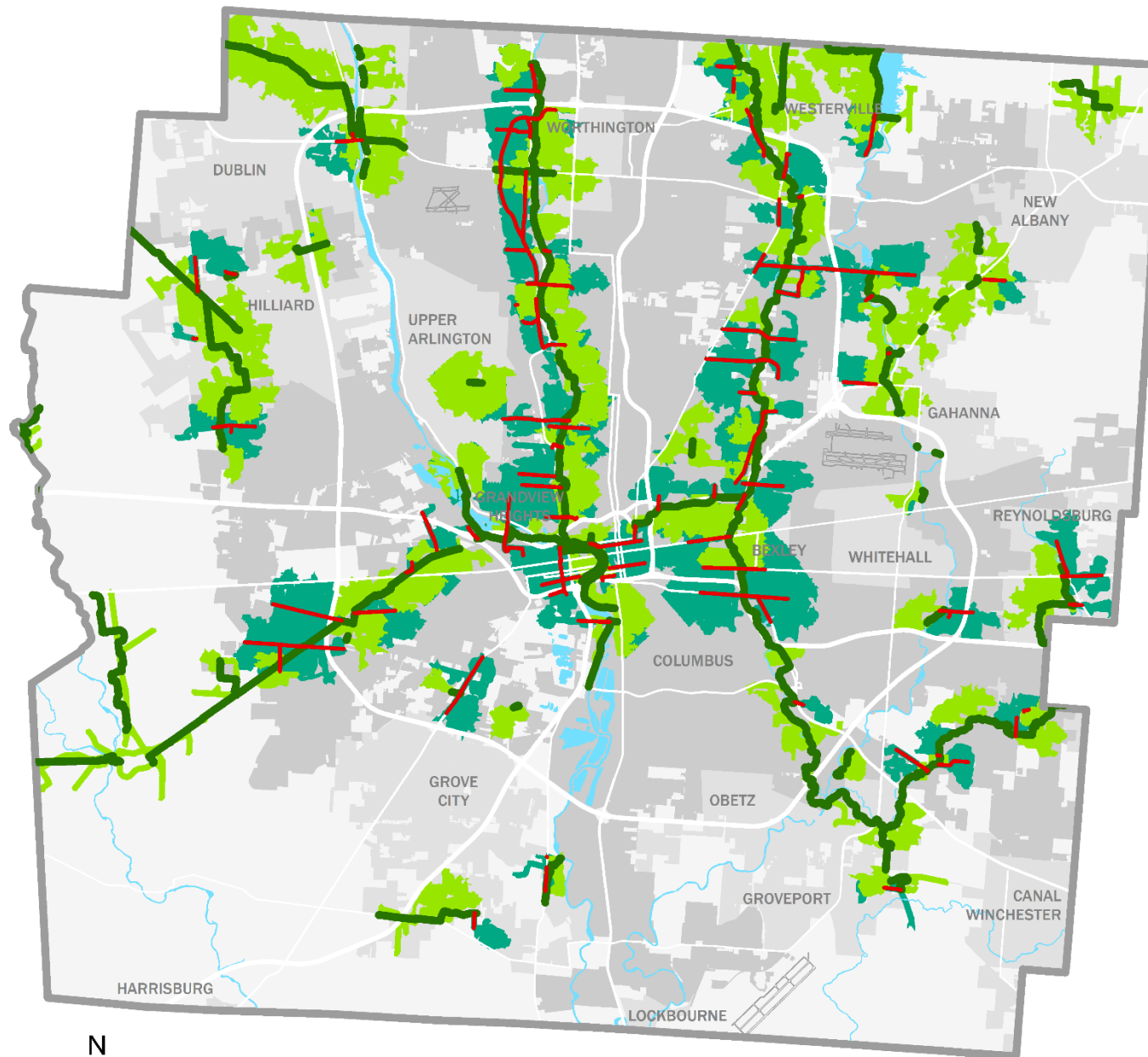

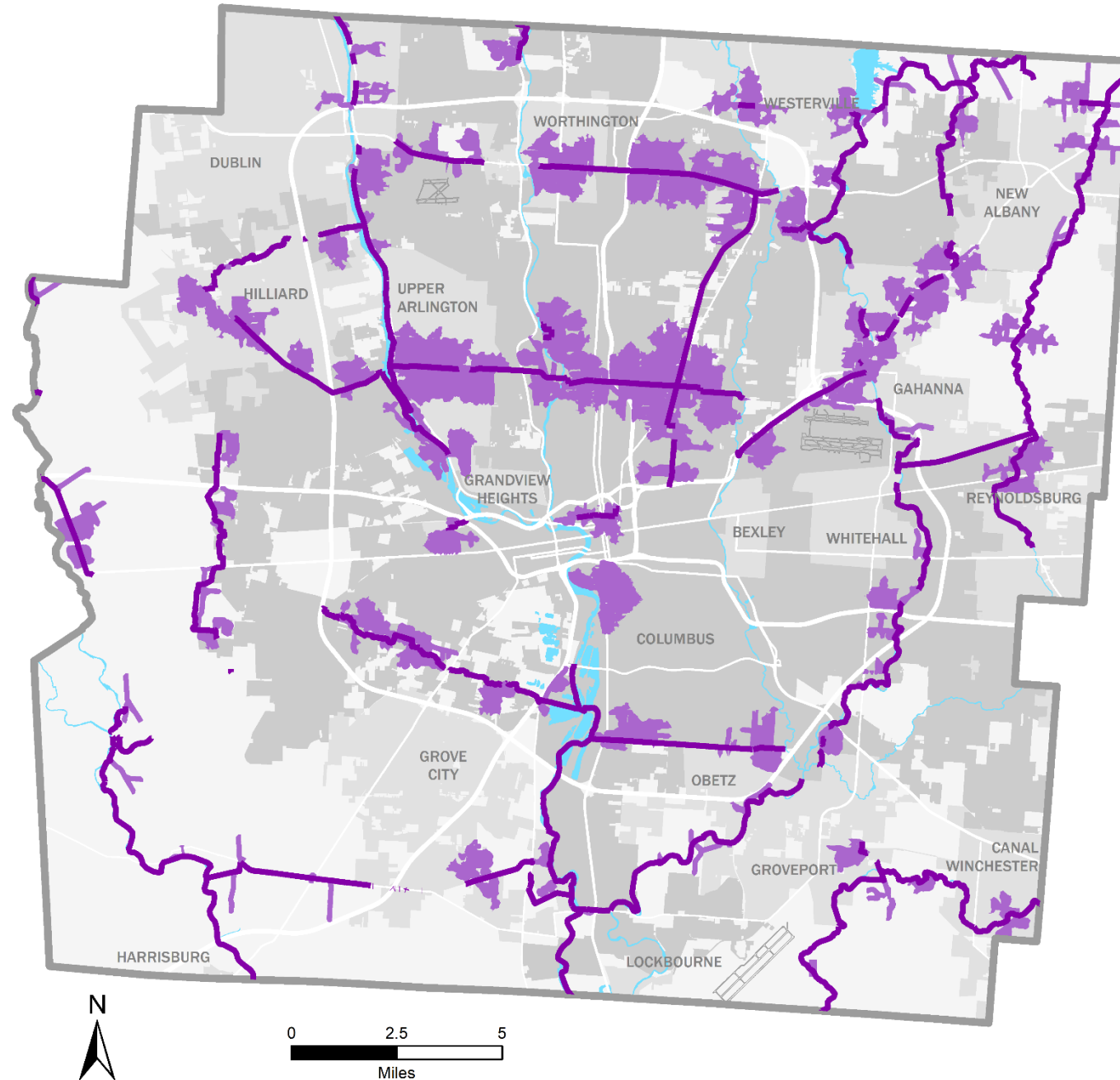
Simulation of expanded bike friendly access, with selected road facility improvements

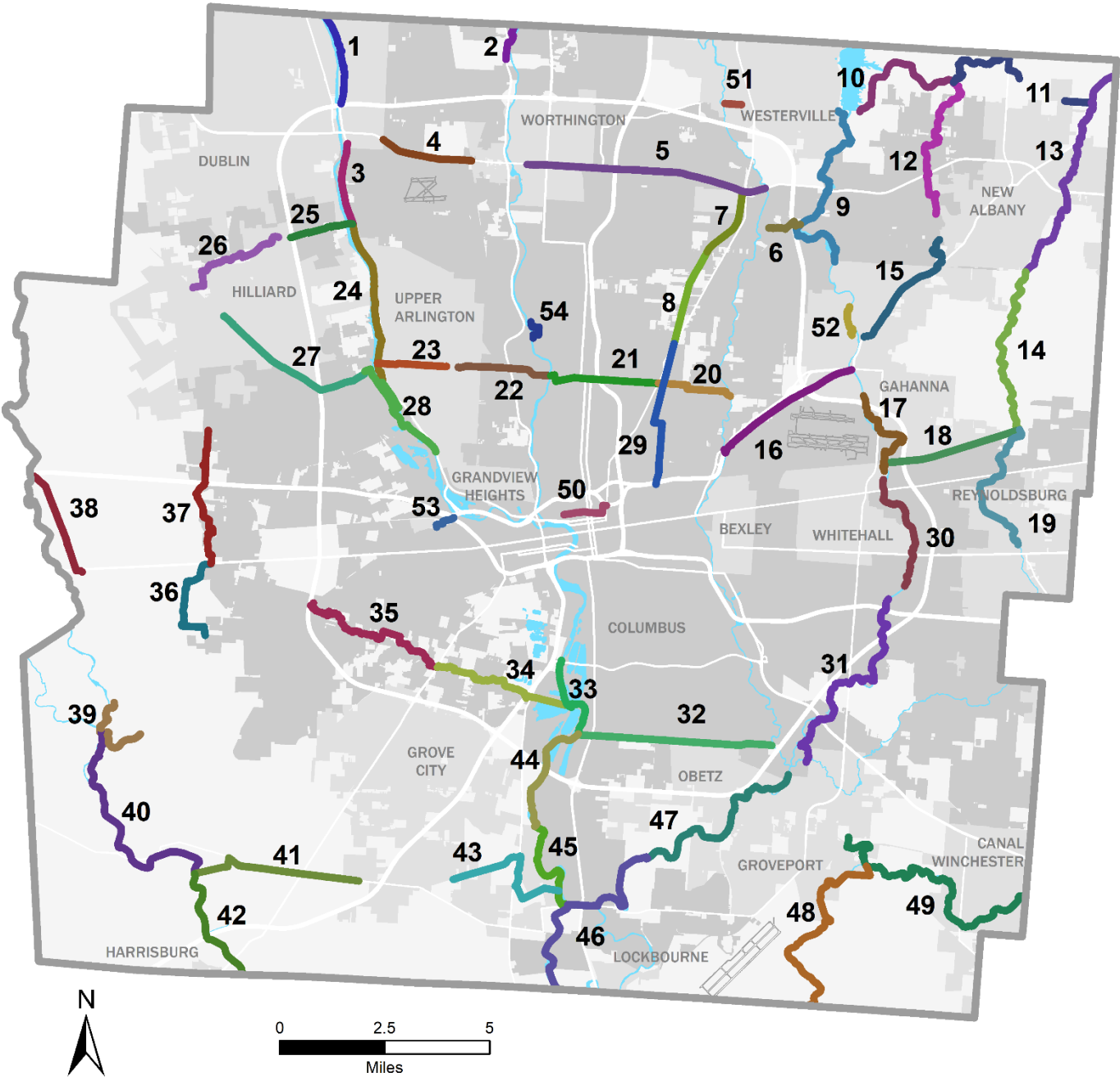

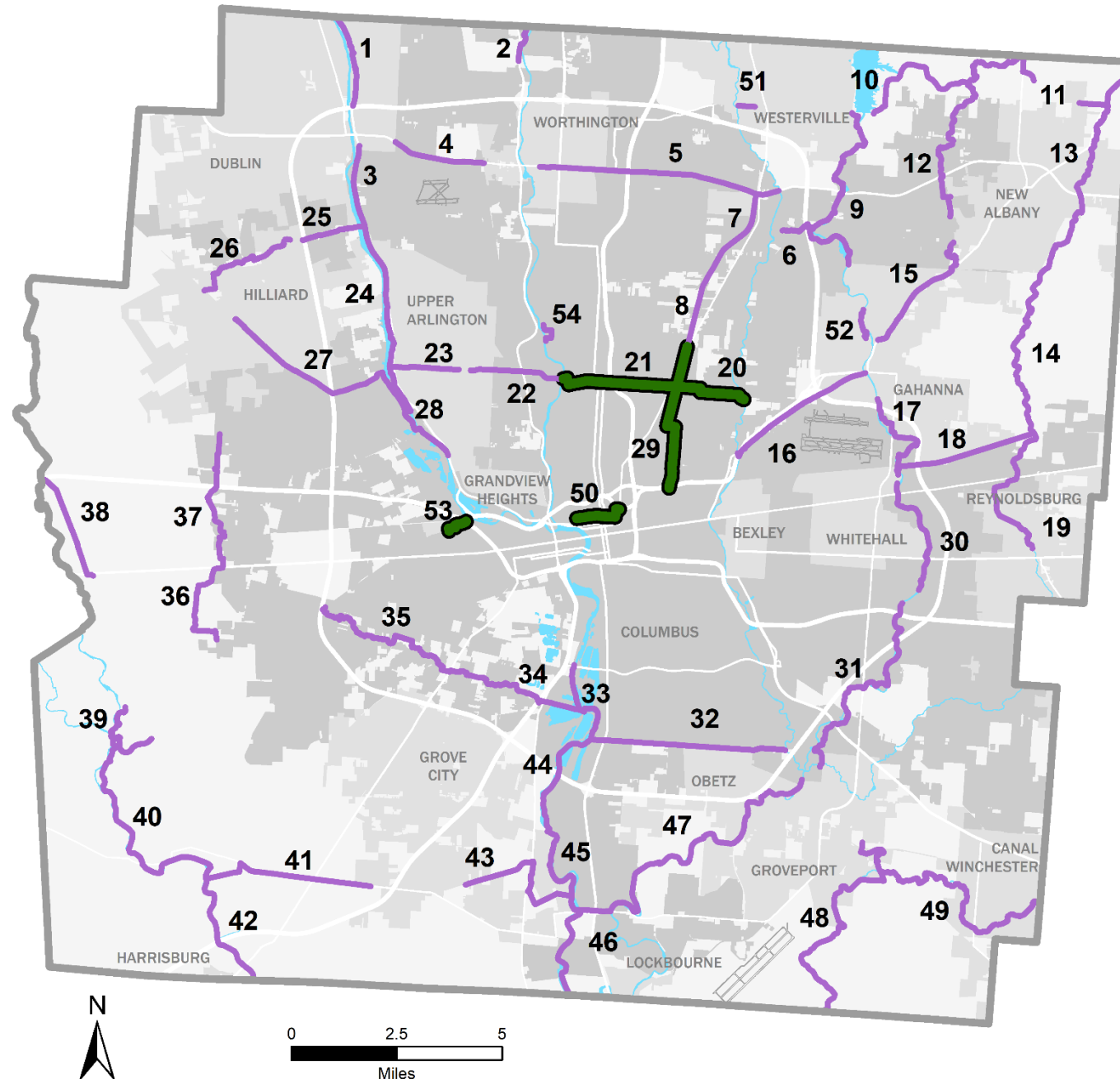

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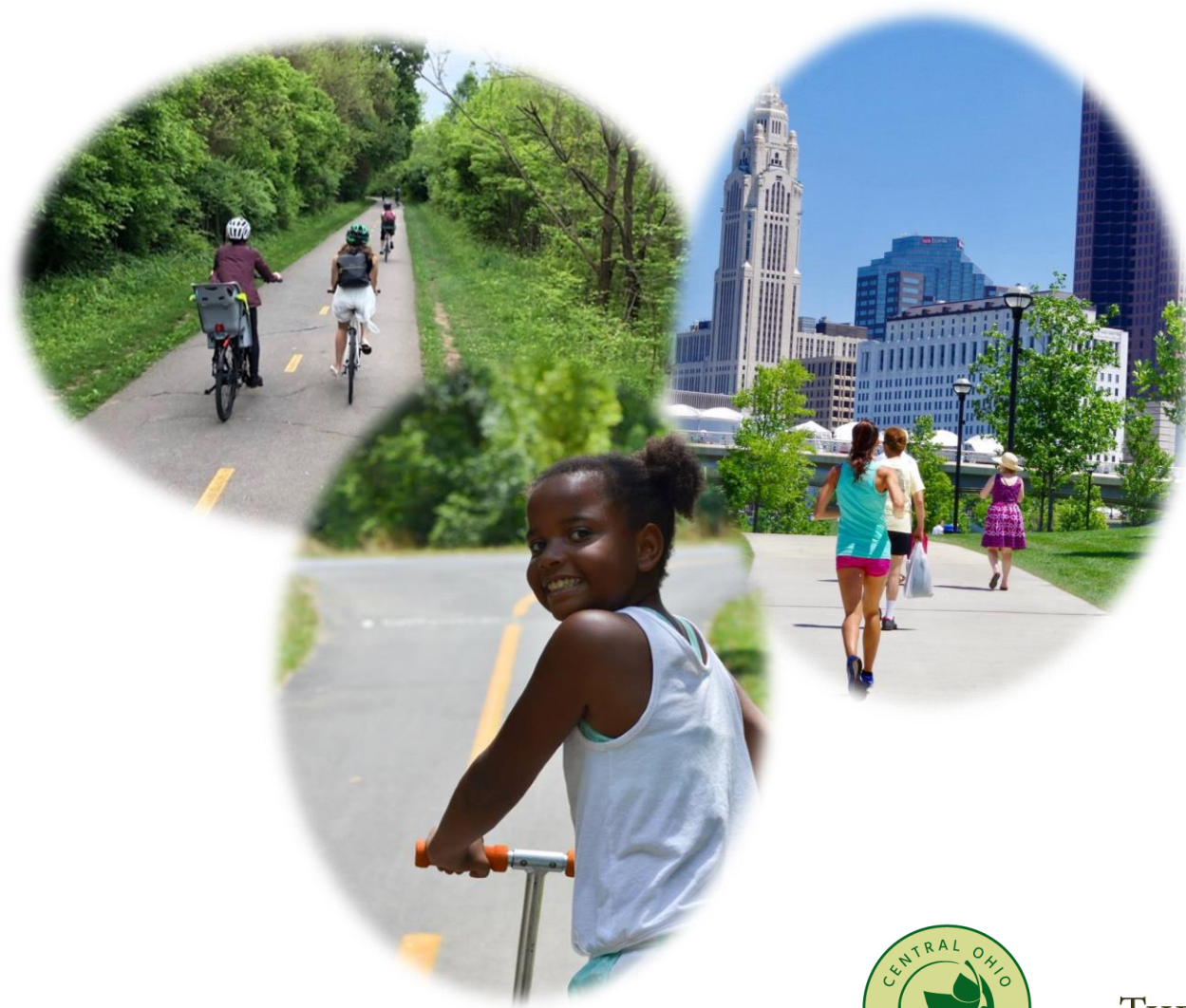

Phase 1: Health & Environment

- Evaluate Trail Count Data
- Trail User Survey
- Estimate Impacts

Phase 2: Equity & Economy

- Quantify livability improvements
- Conduct total cost-benefit analysis
- Demographic Data & Recommend partners focus on high need areas

TRAIL USER SURVEY RESULTS



75% of trail users access the trails by **foot or by bike**

About **33%** of trail users live within **1 mile** of a trail

97% of trail users say **mental health** is improved by when they use trails

44% of people **travel alone** on the trails

20% of trail users **commute** by trail
