Meeting Minutes

A. Pledge of Allegiance

Engineer Robertson called the meeting to order at approximately 2:32 p.m. and led the pledge of allegiance.

B. Roll Call and Introductions

Engineer Robertson asked all attendees to introduce themselves and thanked everyone for attending. Roll was called for board members:

C. Approval of Minutes from February 9, 2022 Meeting

Motion by Easterday, seconded by Janas to approve the meeting minutes of February 9, 2022. Motion carried via a voice vote with all members present voting aye.

D. FCTID Program of Projects

1. Resolution Number 2022-04 Authorizing Funding Agreement and Related Actions for Advancement of the Rohr Road Corridor Improvement Project

Mr. Crosier explained that a private developer along the Rohr Road Corridor (1489 Rohr Holding LLC) was interested in providing a financial contribution to the FCTID for transportation improvements.

Motion by Janas, seconded by Easterday to adopt Resolution 2022-04 to authorize funding agreement with 1489 Rohr Holding LLC for \$1,333,330.00 for advancement of the Rohr Road Corridor Improvement Project.

2. Resolution Number 2022-05 Authorizing Funding Agreement and Related Actions for Advancement of the Renner Road Corridor Improvement Project

Mr. Crosier explained that two private developers along the Renner Road Corridor (Pulte Group, LLC and Harmony Development Group, LLC) were interested in providing financial contributions to the FCTID for transportation improvements.

Motion by Janas, seconded by Easterday to adopt Resolution 2022-05 to authorize funding agreement with Pulte Group, LC and Harmony Development Group, LLC in an amount of \$1,370,540.00 payable to the FCTID for construction costs, and an in-kind contribution of required project engineering services, in the amount of \$465,460 for advancement of the Renner Road Corridor Improvement Project.

 Resolution Number 2022-06 Authorizing Amendment of Intergovernmental Agreement and Related Actions for Advancing the Franklin County Parking Facilities Improvement Project: Phase 3 – Front Street Parking Garage Improvements

Mr. Crosier explained that ODOT's I-70/I-71 Phase 4R/6R project would have significant impacts on Franklin County parking facilities located on Front Street. Mr. Crosier explained that FCEO staff had been in contact with Corna Kokosing and Franklin County PFM staff regarding the necessary work to modify Franklin County parking facilities to address the impacts of ODOT's project.

Motion by Janas, seconded by Easterday to adopt Resolution 2022-06 to authorize preparation and execution of a contract with Corna Kokosing for construction services in an amount not to exceed \$1,250,000 or such lesser amount as determined appropriate from funds made available to the FCTID.

4. Resolution Number 2022-07 Authorizing Applications to ODOT for FY 23 HB 74 Funding for Advancement of Transportation Improvement Projects and Related Actions

Mr. Graham explained that ODOT Jobs and Commerce would be accepting applications for TID Supplemental Funding during the month of March, and informed the board that staff had identified four projects which could be good candidates for this funding. The board discussed the TID Supplemental Funding program with Eddie King.

Motion by Janas, seconded by Easterday to adopt Resolution 2022-07 to authorize preparation and submittal of applications to ODOT for FY 23 TID Supplemental Funding for the Rohr Road Corridor Improvements Project, the Taylor Station Road at Claycraft Road Project, the Alum Creek Drive Corridor Improvements Project, the Rohr Road at SR 317 project, or such other transportation improvement projects that they may subsequently identify for application.
