Meeting Minutes

A. Pledge of Allegiance

Engineer Robertson called the meeting to order at approximately 2:32 p.m., and led the pledge of allegiance.

B. Roll Call and Introductions

Engineer Robertson asked all attendees to introduce themselves and thanked everyone for attending. Roll was called for board members:

C. Approval of Minutes from May 28, 2020 Meeting

Ms. Griffin asked that the meeting minutes from the May 28, 2020 FCTID Board Meeting be amended as follows:

- Item D: Clarification of the approximate cost of property acquisition associated with the Harlem Road at Walnut Street Improvement Project to be defined as \$79,000 for the purchase price of the property and \$2,000 for closing costs.
- Item D: Clarification that Corna Kokosing would be contracted for the pedestrian bridge removal work included in the Franklin County Parking Facilities Improvement Project.

Motion by Beres, seconded by Woodruff to approve the meeting minutes of May 28, 2020 as amended. Motion carried via a roll call vote:

D. FCTID Program of Projects

Mr. Crosier informed the board that the FCTID had acquired the property at the Northeast corner of Harlem Road and Walnut Street on June 15, 2020 for the price of \$79,900 with closing costs totaling \$1,290.50. Additionally, Mr. Crosier informed the board that additional action may need to be taken in coming months to expand the limits of the Harlem Road at Walnut Street Improvement Project.

Mr. Crosier updated the board on the status of the Toy Road, Swisher Road, and Saltzgaber Road Improvement Project, stating that the project had been split into two phases, with both phases currently in design.

Mr. Crosier explained that the Cleveland Avenue at Innis Road project would need to have the scope expanded to accommodate a recent award of ODOT safety funds in the amount of \$3,629,000.00. This alteration to the scope of the project would be proposed in Resolution 2020-14.

Mr. Crosier informed the board that the first phase of the Franklin County Parking Facilities Improvement Project involving removal of the pedestrian bridge over High Street had been approved by the Columbus Downtown Commission. Furthermore, Corna Kokosing had provide an estimate for this work which came in under budget. Mr. Crosier also explained that the Franklin County Board of Commissioners had approved a contribution of \$923,958 to the FCTID to cover the costs of this contract and contingency. Mr. Crosier informed the board that contingent upon approval of Resolution 2020-15, demolition work on this project could begin in Mid-September.

Mr. Crosier updated the board on the status of the Ferris Road Corridor (Karl Road to Westerville Road) project, stating that the project had been awarded safety funds for the construction of a mini roundabout at the intersection of Ferris Road and Walford Road. Construction on this intersection is planned for SFY 2024.

RESOLUTION RE-DESIGNATING "HARLEM ROAD AT WALNUT STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT" TO "WALNUT STREET CORRIDOR (Lee Road to Harlem Road) IMPROVEMENT PROJECT" AND RELATED ACTIONS

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Transportation Improvement District (the "FCTID"), consistent with its purpose and mission, including the designation and development of projects as designated by its Board of Trustees under ORC Chapter 5540, has previously designated by Resolution 2019-02, the "Harlem Road at Walnut Street Improvement Project" as one of its transportation improvement projects that was added to the "FCTID Program of Projects", and which program of transportation projects as further set forth, developed and described on documents on file with the FCTID and FCEO, and which is intended to be amended and supplemented as appropriate to add additional projects, from time to time, as feasible and appropriate;

WHEREAS, the FCTID now intends to hereby re-designate, in the FCTID Program of Projects, and expand the scope of the *Harlem Road at Walnut Street Improvement Project* to the *Walnut Street Corridor (Lee Road to Harlem Road) Improvement Project*, expanding from study of potential intersection improvements at Harlem Road and Walnut Street to various corridor-level roadway improvements along Walnut Street from Lee Road to Harlem Road including, but not limited to, roadway, drainage, and pedestrian infrastructure improvements, as further developed and set forth in plans and documents on file with the FCEO and the FCTID which (referred to hereafter as "*Walnut Street Corridor (Lee Road to Harlem Road) Improvement Project*" or the "Project"), with such improvements to be advanced, in such manner of phases as determined appropriate and feasible by the FCTID, in coordination and collaboration with the FCEO and, as appropriate or necessary, other local jurisdictions and private sector entities with interests in the project area, and funded with available revenues pledged or made available to the FCTID from state or local governments, private funding sources or other identified available funding sources;

WHEREAS, the County and the FCTID, to further develop, facilitate, enhance, fund and promote transportation improvements within the County and the region, through intergovernmental cooperation and coordination by the FCTID and to advance the FCTID Program of Projects, entered into an intergovernmental agreement on file with the FCTID and the County, dated and entered into on November 26, 2019 (the "IGA");

WHEREAS, the County and the FCTID, in furtherance of these goals, intend to amend the IGA, in substantially the from set forth in *"Exhibit A"* attached hereto and made part hereof, to reflect the re-designation of the Project referenced above and as referenced herein; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the FCTID Board of Trustees (the "Board") does hereby re-designate the *Harlem Road at Walnut Street Improvement Project* to the *Walnut Street Corridor (Lee Road to Harlem Road) Improvement Project*, expanding the scope of the Project in accordance with plans and documents as developed and on file with the FCEO, FCTID and ODOT, and further authorizes modification and amendment of the FCTID Program of Projects to reflect the same as described herein, in accordance with and pursuant to ORC Sections 5540.01 (C), 5540.02 (F), 5540.03 (A) (4), (8) and (10) and related sections and FCTID Resolution 2019-02.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board approves and authorizes amendments to the IGA, in substantially the form attached hereto as *Exhibit A*, with only such changes as determined by the FCTID Secretary-Treasurer, in consultation with FCTID Legal Counsel, to not be materially adverse to the FCTID and contingent upon reciprocal approval by the Franklin County Board of Commissioners, and that the taking of any such action and the execution and delivery of any related documents, agreements or instruments, including *Exhibit A* and other project cooperation and funding agreements with respective project implementation partners, including, but not limited to, funding or Project agreements between the FCTID, the County and other governments or private sector entities, including, but not limited to, MI Homes, to provide, in part, for securing and accepting project funding as may be required to advance the Project, including any and all Project phases or segments and in such amounts, solely as determined appropriate and feasible by the FCTID Chairperson or Secretary-Treasurer, in consultation with FCTID Legal Counsel, and which shall be conclusive evidence of the Board's determination that such actions are proper, authorized, approved and necessary in order for the FCTID to carry out the purposes of this resolution and of the authorization thereof by the Board.

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and pertinent provisions of House Bill 97.
