MORPC

Commits ODOT funding for Major New Capacity Program projects

Criteria for project eligibility:

- Overall cost over \$12 million
- Increase capacity and/or reduce congestion
- Proves to support jobs and/or job creation

MPOs and RTPOs provide ODOT a local project prioritization recommendation

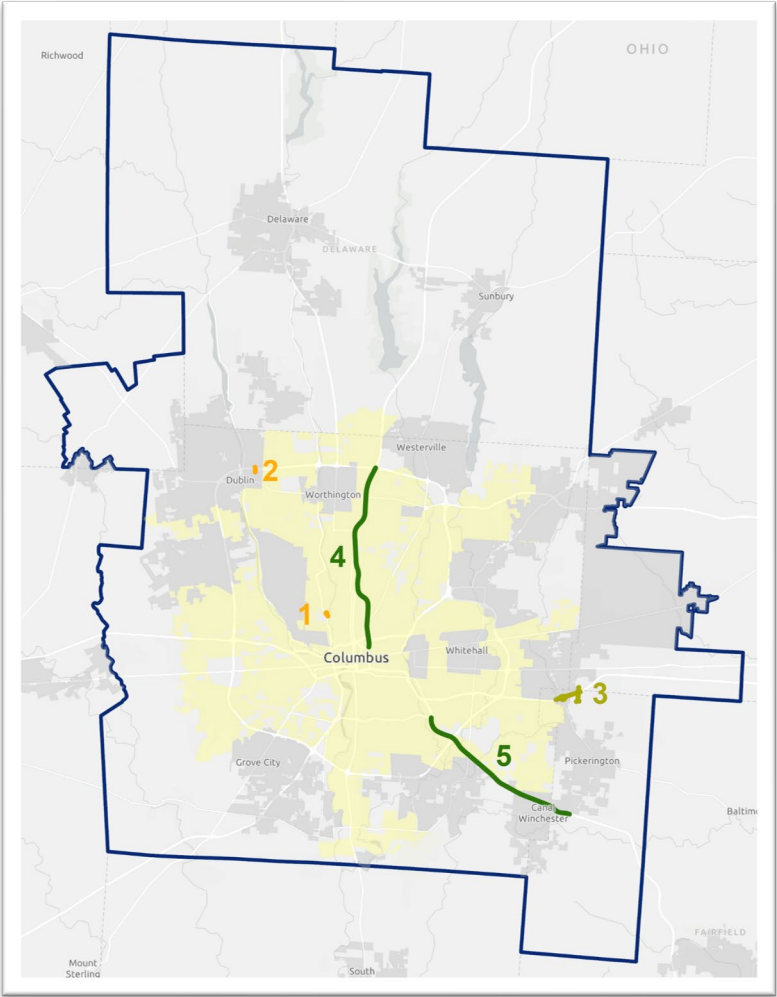

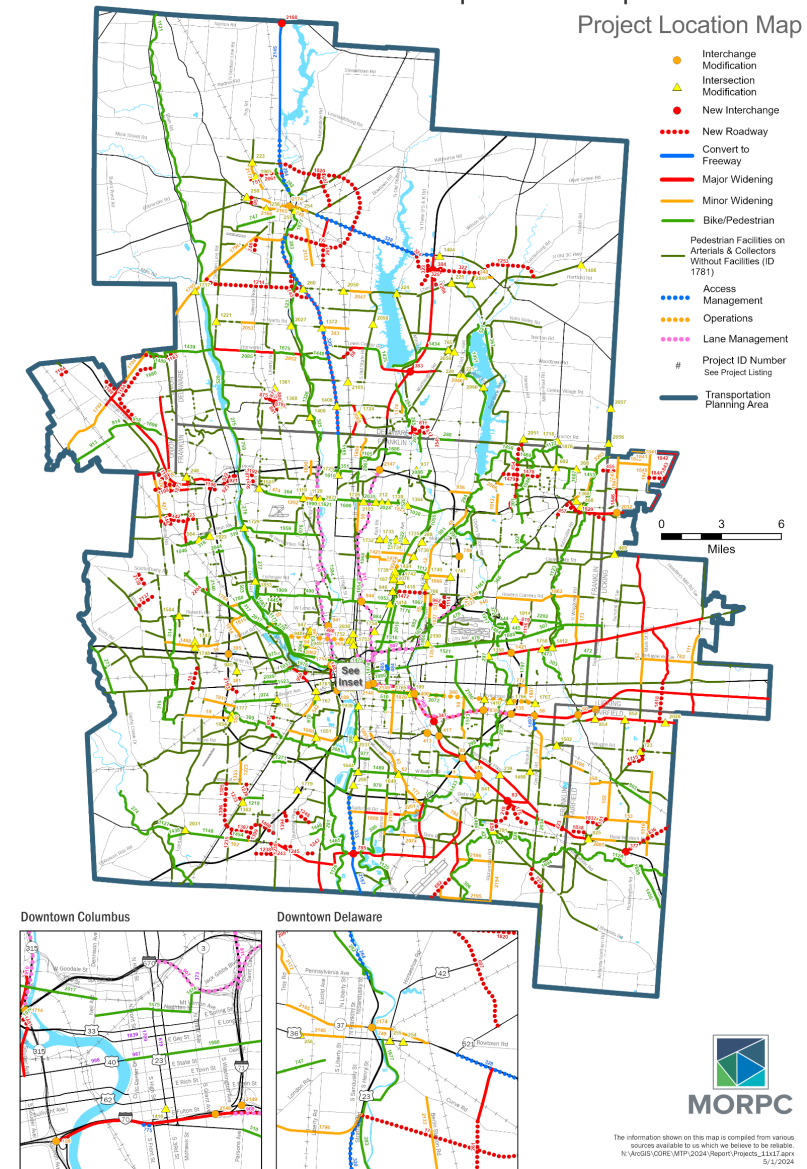


# METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION PLAN (MTP)

  - \$6.6B Non-Freeway Roads
  - \$4.3B Freeway-Related
  - \$1.8B Standalone Bike/Ped
- Implemented by state and local governments through a variety of federal, state, and local funding programs/sources

Metropolitan Transportation Plan

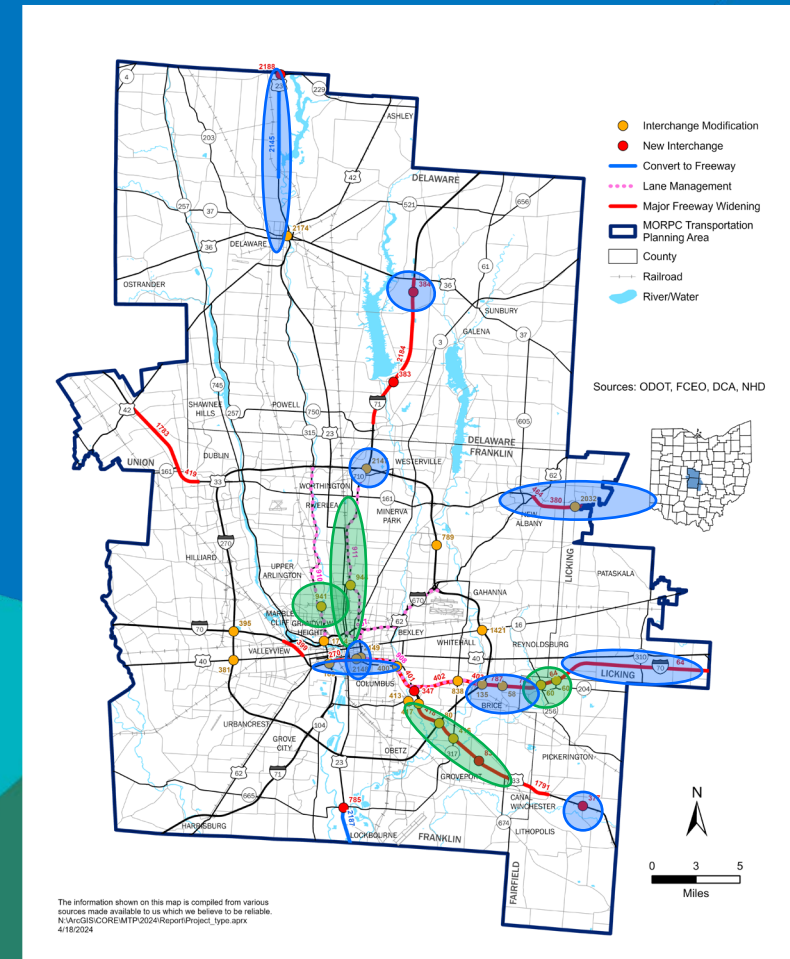
Project Location Map

*Protect natural resources and mitigate infrastructure vulnerabilities to maintain a healthy ecosystem and community.*

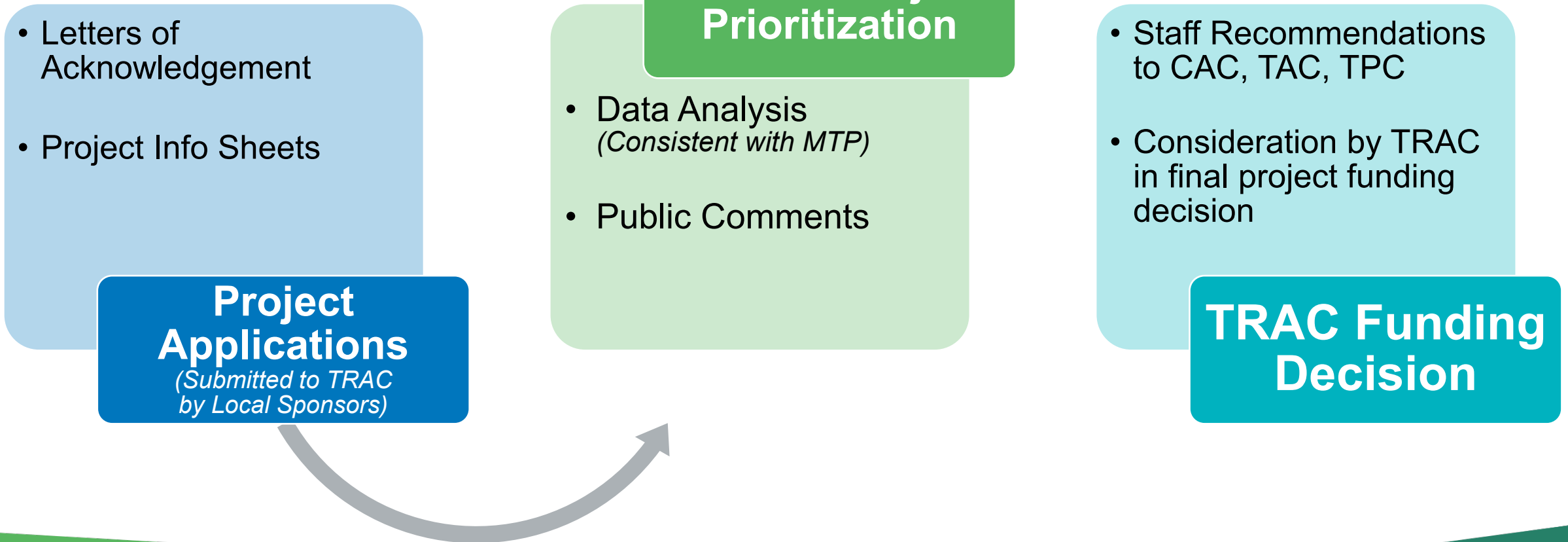
