## TRANSPORTATION REVIEW ADVISORY COUNCIL (TRAC)

Commits ODOT funding for Major New Capacity Program projects

Criteria for project eligibility:

- Overall cost over \$12 million
- Increase capacity and/or reduce congestion
- Proves to support jobs and/or job creation

MPOs and RTPOs provide ODOT a local project prioritization recommendation





# **2024 TRAC APPLICATIONS**




- Total of 28 applications submitted statewide for \$867 million
- **Five** applications from MORPC Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Area
  - I-71 HSR/Smart Lane
  - $\circ$  I-70 and Taylor Rd/SR 256 Interchanges
  - $\circ$  US 33 Southeast Corridor
  - SR 315 North Knot
  - Dublin Emerald Connector
- MORPC MPO area projects requesting total of \$265 million to advance major capital projects



#### METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION PLAN (MTP)

- Implemented by state and local governments through a variety of federal, state, and local funding programs/sources




