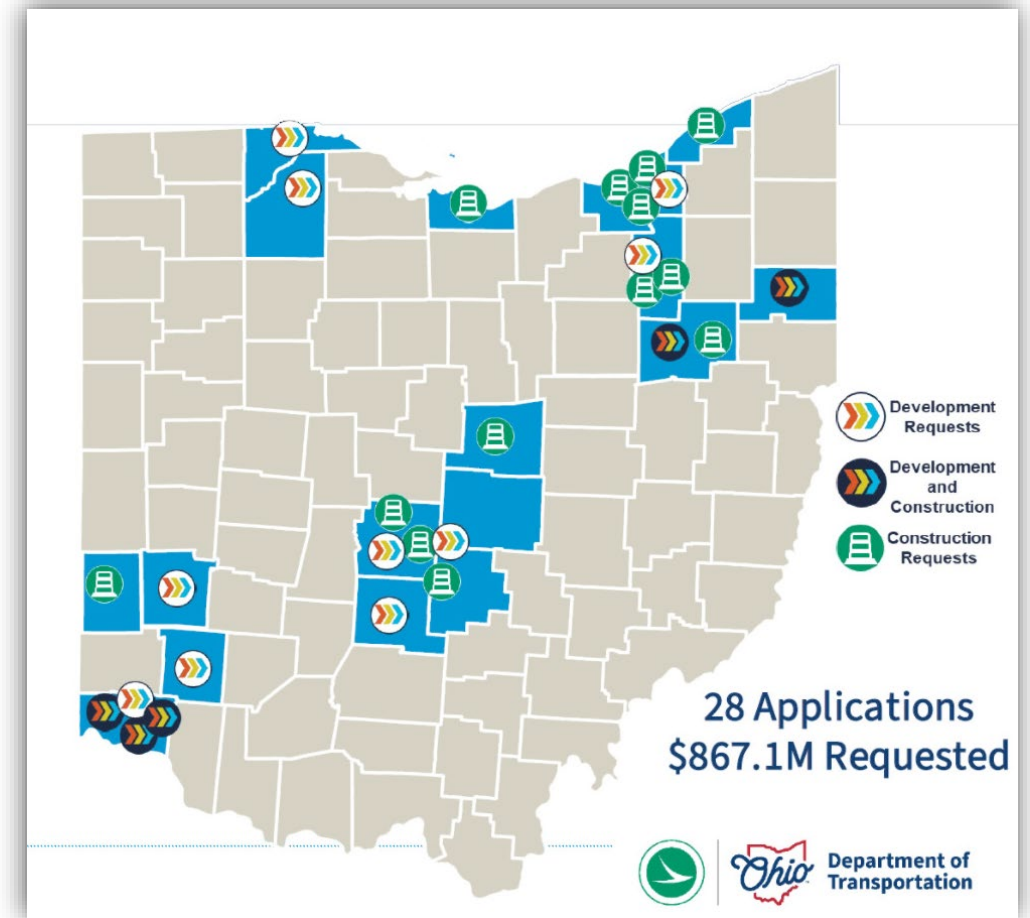

2024 TRAC APPLICATIONS



- Total of **28** applications submitted statewide for **\$867 million**
- **Five** applications from MORPC Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Area
 - **I-71 HSR/Smart Lane**
 - **I-70 and Taylor Rd/SR 256 Interchanges**
 - **US 33 Southeast Corridor**
 - **SR 315 North Knot**
 - **Dublin Emerald Connector**
- MORPC MPO area projects requesting total of **\$265 million** to advance major capital projects

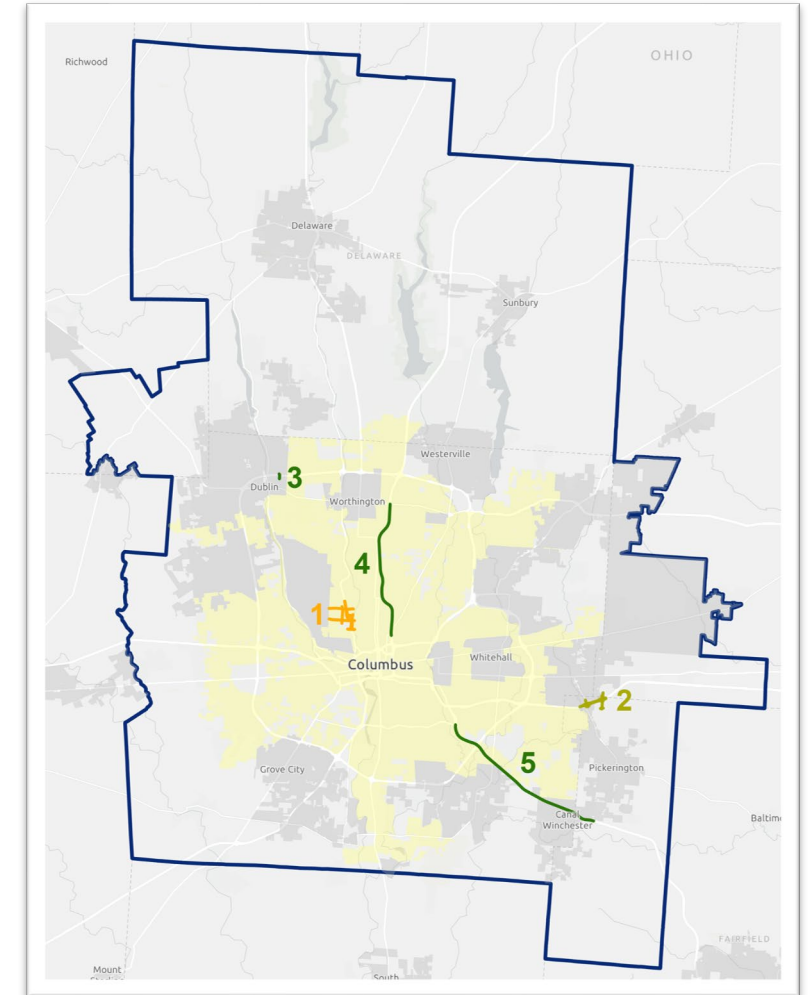

Protect natural resources and mitigate infrastructure vulnerabilities to maintain a healthy ecosystem and community.

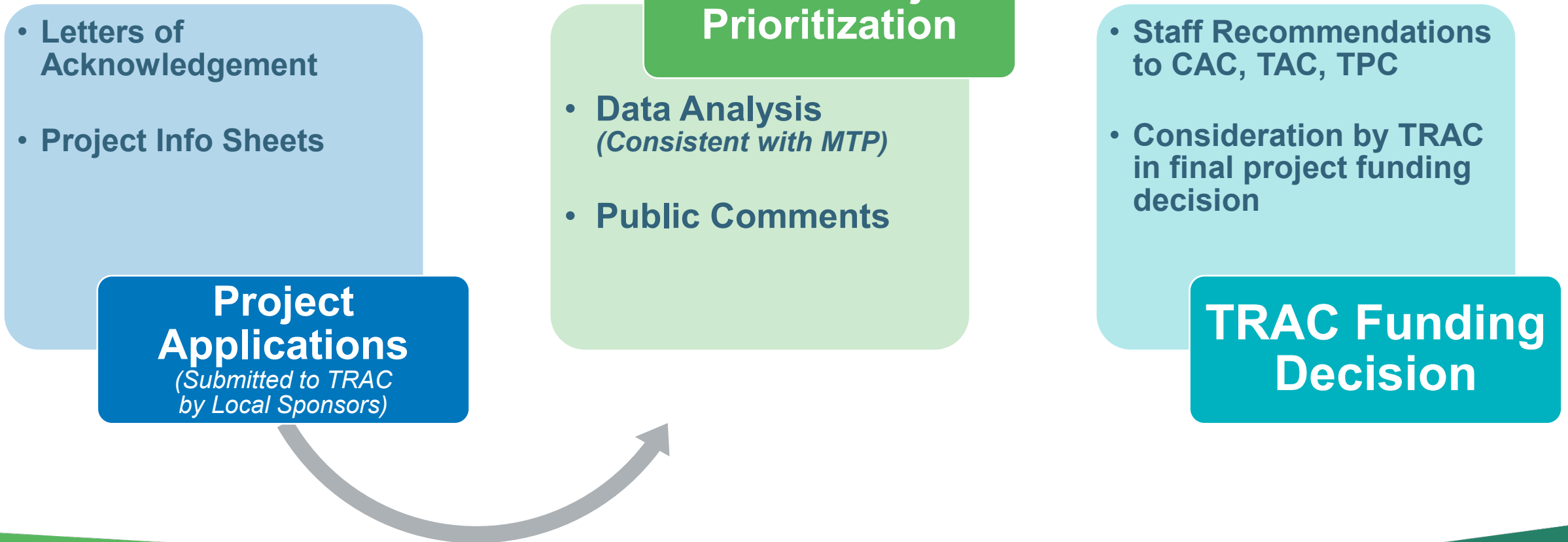


Reduce per capita energy consumption and promote alternative fuel resources to increase affordability and resilience of regional energy supplies.

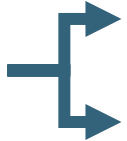
