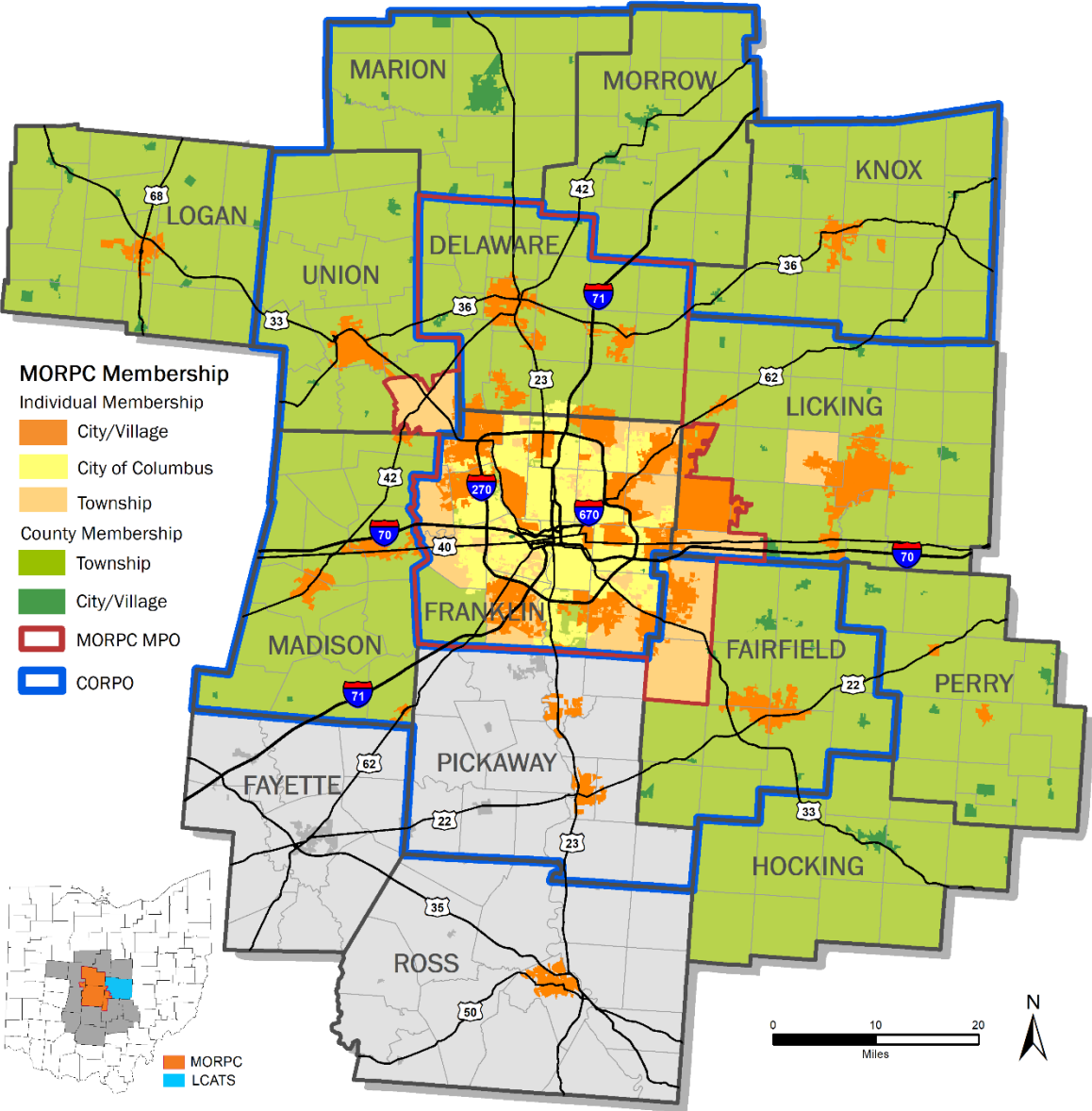

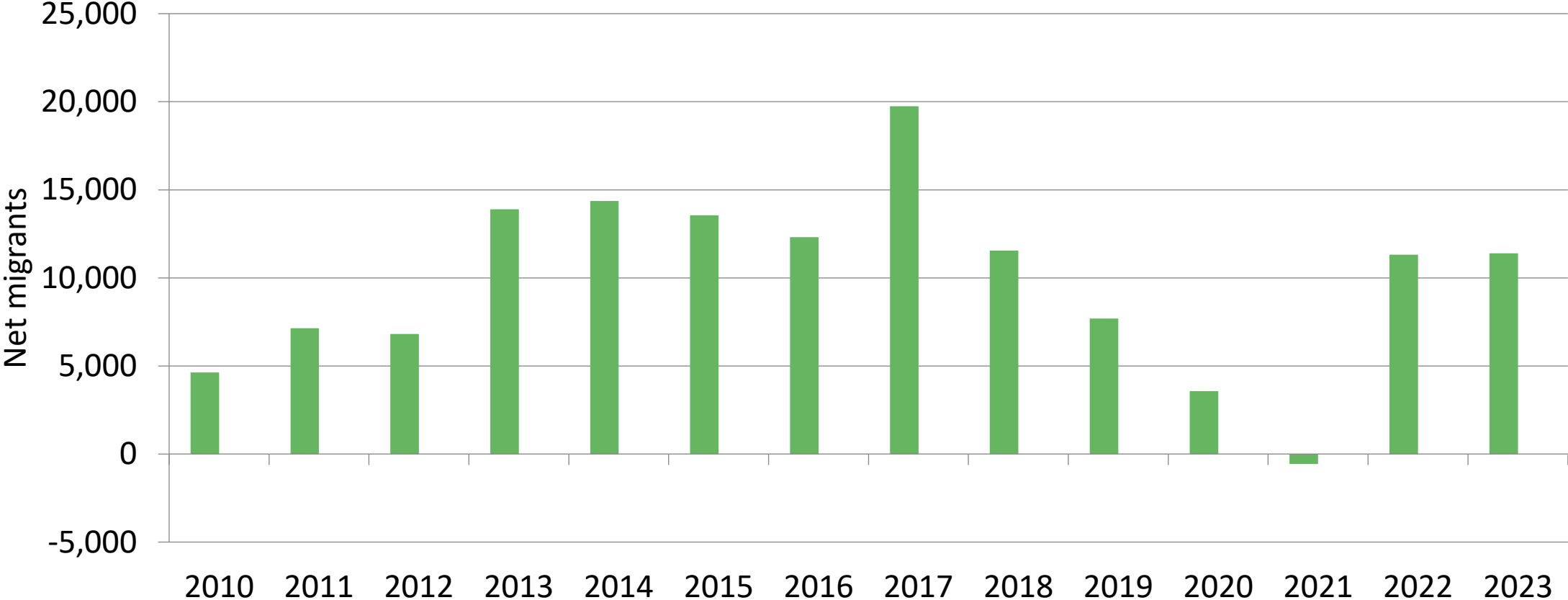

NET MIGRATION TREND

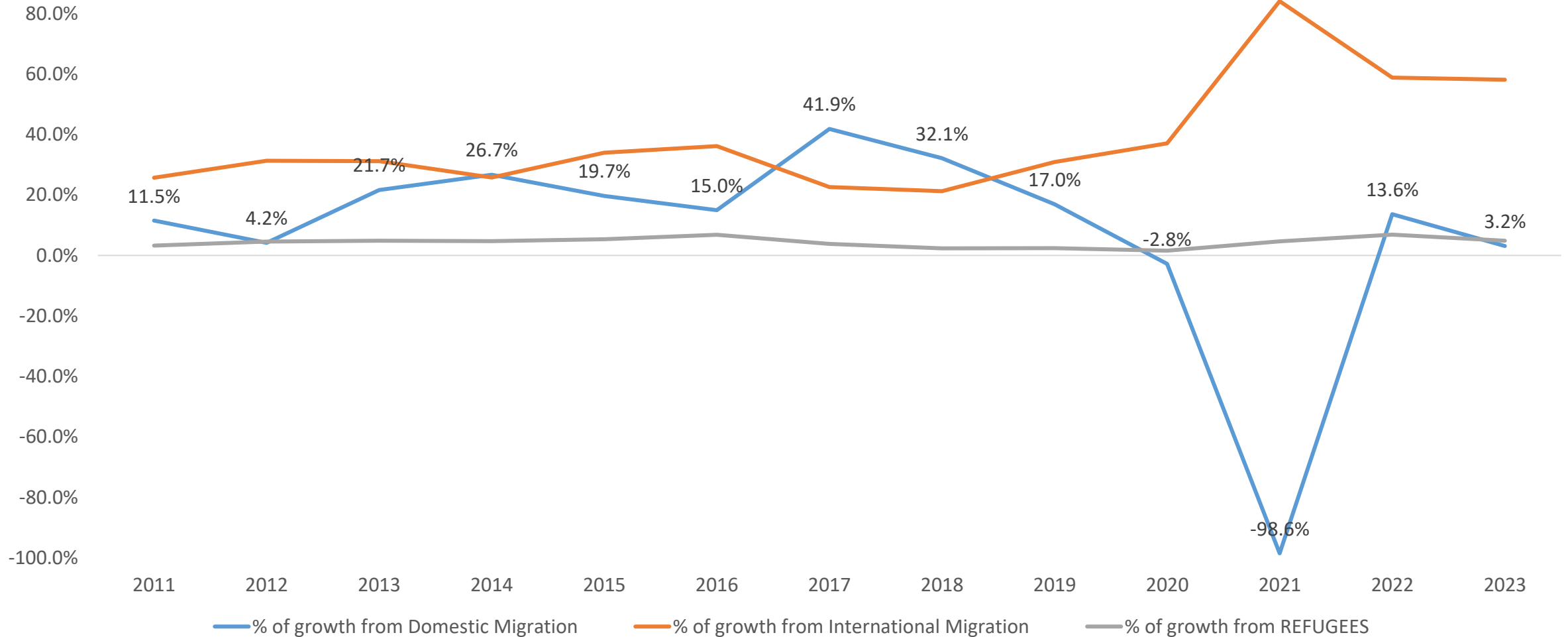
