3. Gohio Presentation

- a. Emily Brown, Commute Coordinator, presented to the FCMAC about Gohio Commute's programs for workforce transportation. Gohio Commute offers services such as carpool ride matching, vanpooling, commuter challenges, and emergency ride home. See slides for more details or email Emily Brown ebrown@morpc.org.
 - i. One member asked the average price of a vanpool. The whole vanpool "package" costs approximately \$1,500 a month but depends on the mileage that the vehicle will be traveling. However, the per person cost is less depending on the MORPC subsidy, how many people are in the van to split the cost, and any potential subsidy on part of the employer.
 - ii. Gohio Commute anticipates launching their new app in Q2.
 - iii. Gohio Commute is rolling out their new Commute Perks incentives. Commute Perks will allow people to log their sustainable commute trips to be eligible for rewards and discounts to national and local retailers. Biking, teleworking, walking, carpooling, vanpooling, and

transit are all eligible modes. You only have to log 5 trips per month to be eligible for rewards.
