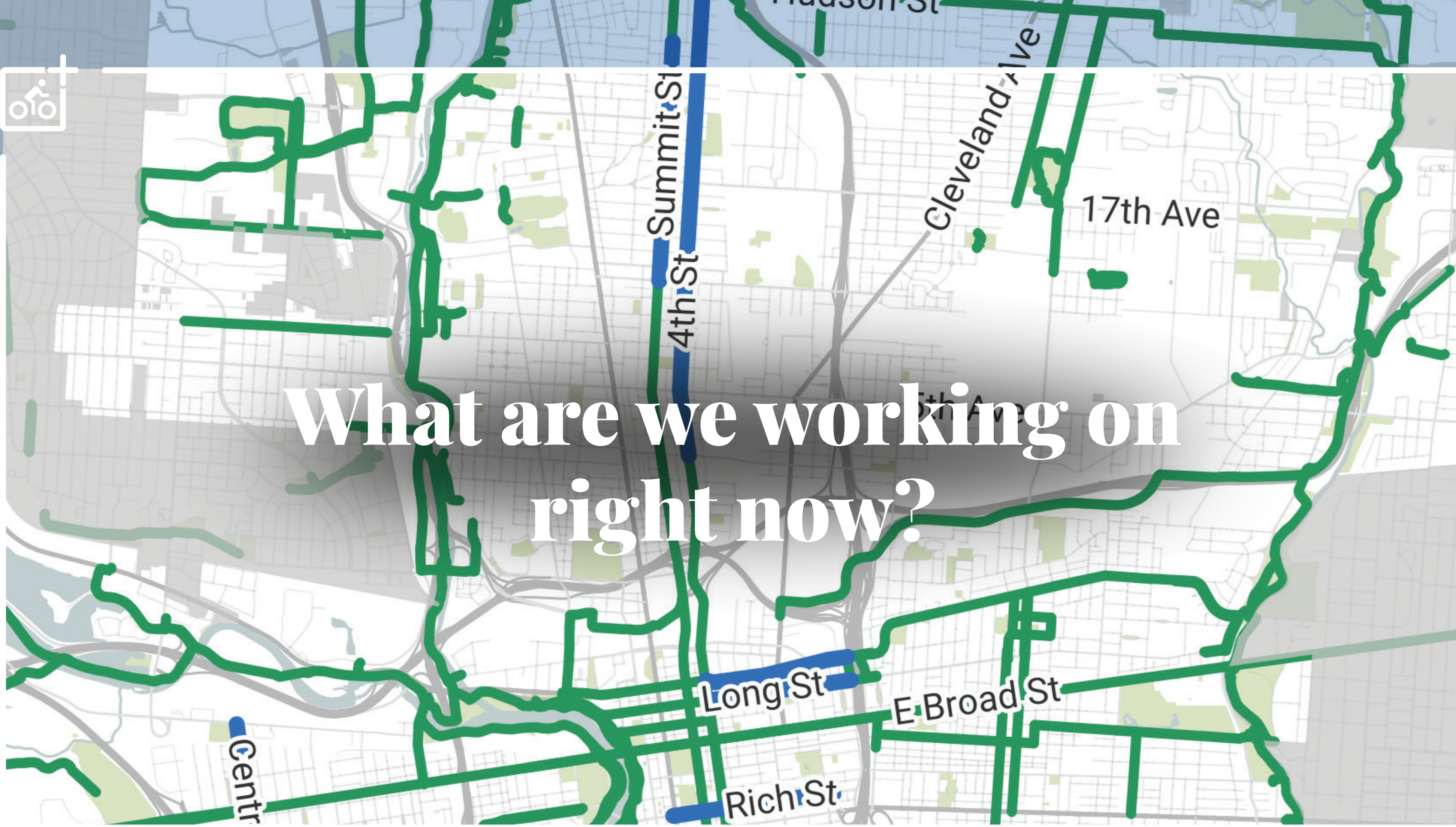

2024 Summer

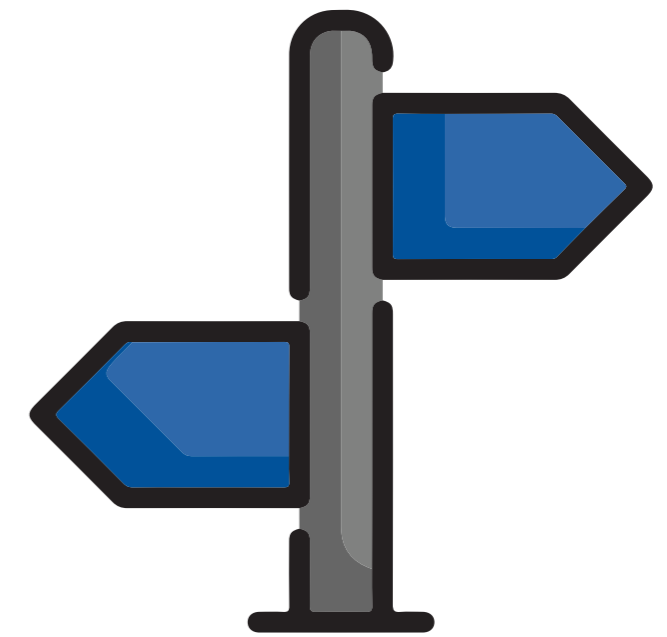
Demonstration

One travel lane will be reallocated on each side of Broad Street between Parsons Avenue and Nelson Road to accommodate protected bicycle lanes and seek to slow vehicular travel speeds.



Future Capital Trail

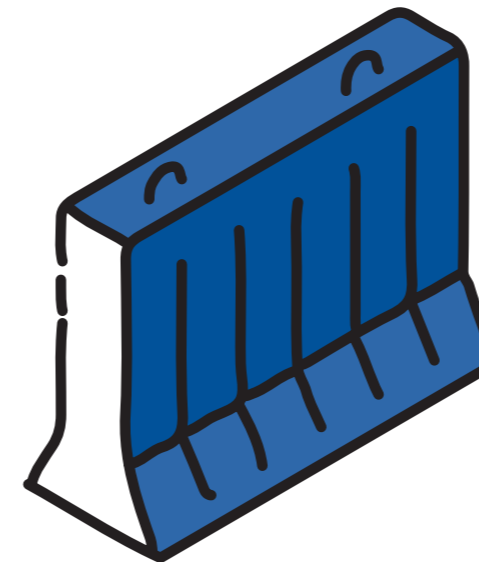
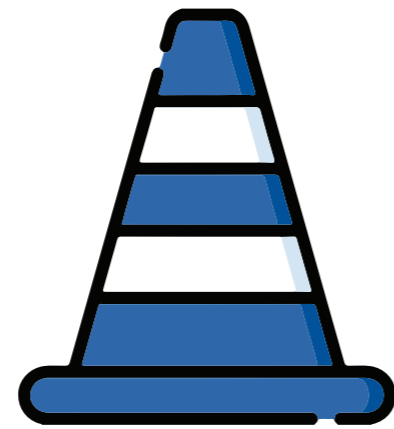
A premium trail connecting the Scioto and Alum Creek greenways will be constructed to increase vulnerable road user safety and connectivity along East Broad Street.



2026

Resurfacing

East Broad Street is to be resurfaced from Parsons Avenue to Nelson Road by the Ohio Department of Transportation. This work will incorporate lessons learned from the Demonstration project and include protected bicycle facilities.

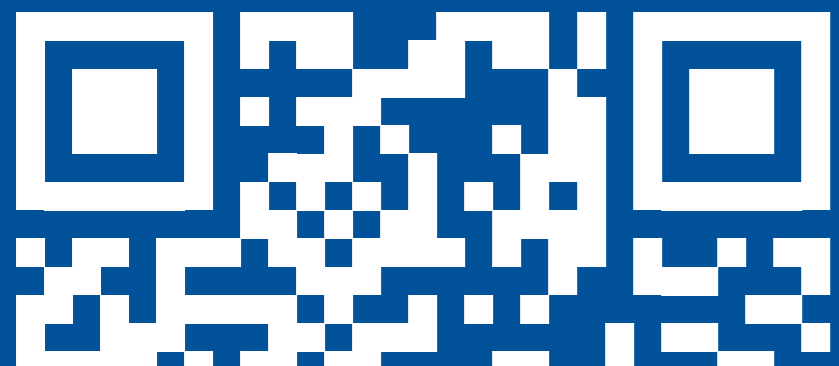
