

- Law enforcement responded over the next several days
 - 36 County Sheriff's sent Deputy's
- At least 7 Police Departments sent officers
 - To include but not limited to Dublin, Marysville, Jackson Center, Waynesfield, Washington Twp., Russells Point.

Fire and EMS

 Representatives from nearly every Fire and EMS in Logan County responded to the Indian Lake area for the hours and days afterwards to assist in the building searches and treatment of injured individuals.

Long Term Recovery

 The long-term recovery committee has helped families and individuals in many ways. Financially with donated funds, housing with available monies and donated funds, this committee has assisted with permanent housing needs and assisted in the placement of house trailers for some families.

Partners in recovery

- **St. Vincent DePaul** House in a Box so far, we have referred 12 families to receive replacement of all of their household possessions.
- Bridges had a \$50,000 grant in 2024 that assisted with replacing appliances, utility bill assistance, and other services
 - Habitat for Humanity 1 new build is under roof now; HFH has completed installing 5 to 7 trailer roofs.
 - Multiple churches and faith-based organizations
- **Residential Administrators** has been a Rock Star in helping locate housing for people in difficult situations.
- Long Term Recovery We currently have 28 open cases, with 10 of those being actively in the process of receiving services.
