Questions & Answers

Q 1: Would the successful applicant for this RFP be precluded from bidding on and awarded any design and installation work that may result from member communities as part of the developed study?

A 1: No, the successful applicant would not be precluded from bidding on any other RFPs related to EV charging, design, or installation.

Q 2: How is this EV Charging Siting Study and Sustainable Energy Support being funded?

A 2: This work is being funded with MORPC local dollars.

Q 3: Can the deadline be extended?

A 3: Yes, we extended the deadline to Monday, May 15th at 5 pm.

Q 4: On page 5 under “proposal format”, the RFP states that proposals shall not exceed “twenty (10)” pages. Does this translate to ten front and back pages (equaling to twenty sheets) or ten sheets total? Please clarify.

A 4: We apologize for the confusion. It should read that the total length of the proposal shall not exceed twenty (20) pages, which could be 20 pages (front only) or 10 pages (front & back).
